This amigurumi is worked with welladjusted stitches and mostly in a spiral shape, do not close each turn unless if you are instructed to do so, you will have to be careful and always mark the start of each lap. Please read the entire pattern before you begin.
In the description before buying this pattern I told you that we have a tutorial on our channel to make this amigurumi.

## This Princess measures approximately 29 cm

## Materials that I have used:

- Yarn 100\% Mercerized Cotton of 6 strands, Colors: wheat color for the skin 66 g , white and brown for details in her eyes, black, strong water and gold or gold color.
- 2.5 mm hook
- Wool needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- $100 \%$ hypoallergenic filling
- Silicone tube, 1 cm diameter and 12 cm long or more
- Pins
- 10mm safety eyes
- Blush for your cheeks
- Closure for dress


## Abbreviations:

R: round
c: chain
MR: Magic ring sc: single crochet
hoc: half double crochet dc: double crochet
dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)
inc: Increase ( 2 sc in 1 stitch) triple inc: Increase ( 3 sc in 1 stitch) hoc inc: Increase (2mpa in 1stitch) dc inc: Increase (2pa in 1stitch) ss: slip stitch

FLO: front Loop only
BLO: Back Loops only

Note: You can use this same pattern To make this amigurumi bigger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this
thread it will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes and the bra for your neck.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did when designing it for you.

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Gretawings

Let's start with the body

Arms (Make 2)
Wheat Color
V1: AM 6sc
V2: Gaum (12)
V3-7: 12sc (60sc in total)
V8: (4sc, 1dis) x2 (10)
Rnd 9-24: 10sc (160sc in total)


Cut strand at the end of each Arm and Fill

## Legs (Make 2)

Start with Wheat color yarn
R1: 4ch,in the 2nd start(2sc,7triple inc) $\times 2$ (10)

Note: I suggest you mark Chain number 4 before starting to make the first single crochet, because once we knit the 2 nd repetition on the other side of the chains, right in that 4 th string is where we will do the last triple increase

When you enter the link that I share below the image you will notice that in that video the body is made with other colors, but you will use the colors that I indicate for this specific princess.

R2: (2sc, 3inc)×2 (16)
R3: 3sc, $4 \mathrm{inc}, 4 \mathrm{sc}, 4 \mathrm{inc}, 1 \mathrm{sc}(24)$
R4-6: 24sc
R7: 6dec, 12sc (18)
R8: 18sc
R9: 3dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (14)
R10-30: 14sc (294sc in total)
Note: On the first leg that you made, you will cut the strand and in the second leg you will change to Strong Water color in the last single crochet of the R30 to make the underwear.

You will join the two legs forming a single piece R31: 9sc on the same leg where you made the color change, 2ch, starting at the $3 r d$ point of the other leg in such a way that both are with the toes facing forward, 14sc, 2sc on the $2 \mathrm{ch}, 5 \mathrm{sc}$ on the leg who started this round (this round will end with 32 points)

R32-36: 32sc
R37: (6sc, 1dec) $\times 4$ (28) Change to Flesh color in the last decrease of this $V$
R38: 28sc
R39: (5sc, 1dec) x4 (24)
R40-48: 24sc
R49: 4sc, 10sc in 1 arm, 12sc, 10sc in another arm, 8sc (44)
Note: You can also secure the strand that was left in the arm.

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## Head

R59: 12inc (24)
R60: (3sc, linc)×6 (30)
R61: (4sc, linc)×6 (36)
R62: 2sc, linc, (5sc, linc) $\times 5$, 3sc (42)
R63: (6sc, linc) x6 (48)
R64: 3sc, linc, (7sc, linc) $\times 5$, 4sc (54)
R65: 54sc
R66: (8sc, linc)×6 (60)
R67: 4sc, linc, (9sc, linc) $\times 5,5 \mathrm{sc}$ (66)
R68: (10sc, linc)×6 (72)
R69-77: 72s c
Place the eyes between the R73 and R74 with approximately 13 points of separation.

Place the silicone tube or the material you want to use to support your head, it may be easier if you make a tip to the silicone, please see the link for more details. You can also place it whenever you want and you consider how to knit more at ease

R78: (10sc, 1dec)×6 (66)
R79-81: 66sc
R82: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60)
R83: 3sc, 1dec,(8sc, 1dec) $\times 5$, 5sc (54)
R84: (7sc, 1dec)×6 (48)
R85: 3sc, 1dec,(6sc, 1dec)x5, 3sc (42)
R86: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)
Note: After the R86 fill as much as possible so that the filling will firm up the material you placed in the center, if you are using a silicone tube cut it right where the head ends, continue closing with the following rounds and at the same time filling if necessary.


R87: (4sc, 1dec)×6 (30)
R88: (3sc, 1dec)×6 (24)
R89: (2sc, 1dec)×6 (18)
R90: (1sc, 1dec)×6 (12)
R91: 6dec (6)
Close with wool needle

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## Ears (Make 2)

R1: MR 5sc
R2: turn, 2sc, linc, 2sc (6)
Leave the long thread to sew to the head.

Place the ears 8sc apart from each safety eye

R1: MR 6sc
R2: 6inc (12)
R3: (1sc, linc)x6 (18)
R4: (2sc, linc) x6 (24)
R5: (3sc, linc)×6 (30)
R6: (4sc, linc)×6 (36)
R7: (5sc, linc)×6 (42)
R8: (6sc, linc)×6 (48)
R9: (7sc, linc)×6 (54)
R10: (8sc, linc)×6 (60)
R11: 60sc
R12: 4sc, linc, (9sc, linc) $x 5$, 5sc (66)
R13: 66sc
R14: (10sc, linc)×6 (72)
R15-20: 72sc
R21-23: 36sc, 36hdc (72)
Continue with the locks
Locks (Make 18)
Black FLO 1ss (92ch, in the 2nd start, 1sc, 90 hdc, skip 1point, 1ss)×18

## Ribbons (Make 4)

Strong water 21ch, in the 2 nd start, 20sc
Cut strand leaving it long for the union
Note: You will need 3 ribbons for the bow and 1 for the headband where you will then put the stone in the center (See link).

## Gemstone

Strong water R1: MR (2sc, 3hdc)×2 (10)
Change to gold color
R2: BLO 10ss
Close with a wool needle
This gemstone will be placed in the center of the headband tilted forward.

Pants Legs (Make 2)
Color Gold R1: 20ch, close with 1ss in the 1st chain forming a ring, BLO 20sc.

R3: BLO 2Oinc (40)


R4-6: 40sc
R7: (8sc, 1dec)×4 (36)
R8-9: 36sc
R10: 3sc, 1dec, (7sc, 1dec) $\times 3$, 4sc (32)
R11-13: 32sc
R14: (6sc, 1dis) $\times 4$ (28)
R15-25: 28sc

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Union
R26: 28sc on the other leg, 28sc on the next leg (56)

R34: (3sc, $3 \mathrm{hdc}, 4 \mathrm{dec} \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{hdc}, 3 \mathrm{sc}) \times 2$ (32) Change to gold color

R35: 1ss, 2ch, in the same base start, 4dc, 2hdc, 20sc, 2hdc, 4dc, 1ss (32)


This will be the front


AND this will be the back


## Blouse

## Strong water

R1: 31ch, in the 2nd start 30sc (30) R2-4: turn, 30sc
R5: turn, 8sc, 13ch, skip 1sc, 12sc, 13ch, skip 1sc, 8sc (54)

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To close this blouse from behind you can place a stick, a clasp or sew, as you wish

R7: 54sc Change to gold color R8: turn, ss around the edge of the blouse. Make a chain to close the piece.

Strong water
R1: 4ch, in the 2nd beg (2sc, 7triple inc) $\times 2$ (10)
R2: (2sc, 3inc)×2 (16)
R3: (2sc, 6inc) x2 (28)
R4: 28sc Taking the back strand R5-8: 28sc
R9: 2sc. 6dec, 14ss (22)
R10: 10ss, 12sc (22)
Close with a wool needle
