This amigurumi is worked with tight  
stitches and mostly in a spiral pattern,  
do not close each round unless  
prompted, you will have to be careful  
and always mark the start of each  
round. Please read the entire pattern  
before starting.

This Princess measures approximately 30cm

#### Materials:

- 100% Mercerized Cotton Yarn, Colors: Green, Flesh Color 60g, Red 90g, Lilac, Yellow, strong aqua or aqua, white and strong Cinnamon or brown.
- 2.5mm hook Yarn
- needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- 100% hypoallergenic
- padding Silicone tube, 1cm diameter and 14cm long or more preferably
- Pins
- 10mm safety eyes
- Blush for your cheeks

#### Abbreviations:

- R: round
- ch: chain
- MR: Magic ring
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- dc: double crochet
- dec : decrease (2sc together)
- hdc dec: decrease (close 2hdc together)
- hdc dc: decrease (close 2dc together)
- inc : Increase (2sc in 1st)
- triple inc: Increase (3sc in 1st)
- inc dc: Increase (2dc in 1st)
- inc sc: Increase (2dc in 1st)
- ss: Slip stitch
- FLO: Front Loop Only (take only the front thread)
- BLO: Back Loops Only (take only the back thread)

Note: You can use this same pattern to make This amigurumi larger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes and the support for her neck.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it



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Let's start with the body

### Arms (Make 2)

Use Flesh Color yarn

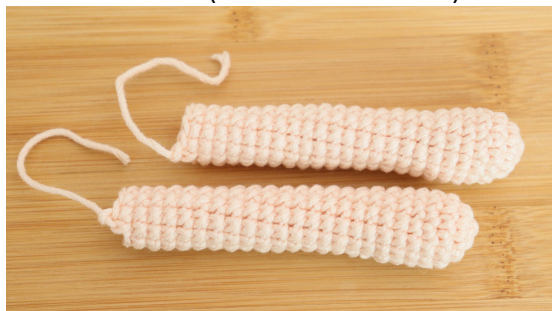
R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3-7: 12sc (60sc in total)

R8: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10)

R9-24: 10sc ( 160sc in total)



Cut the yarn at the end of each Arm and Fill them, then join them to the body without seams.

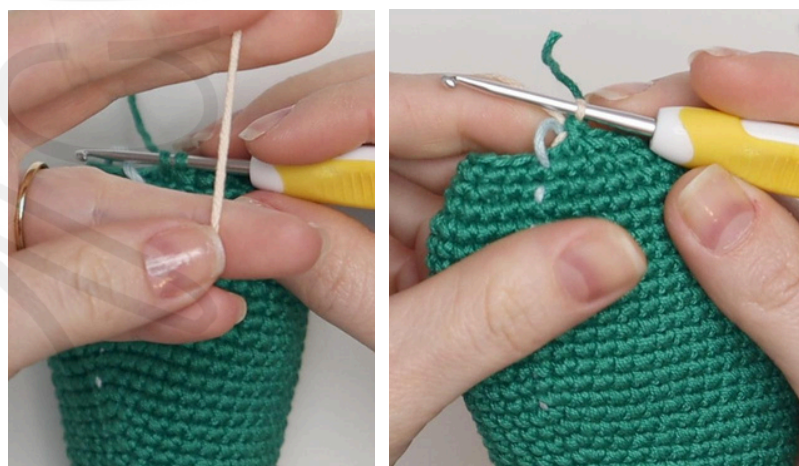

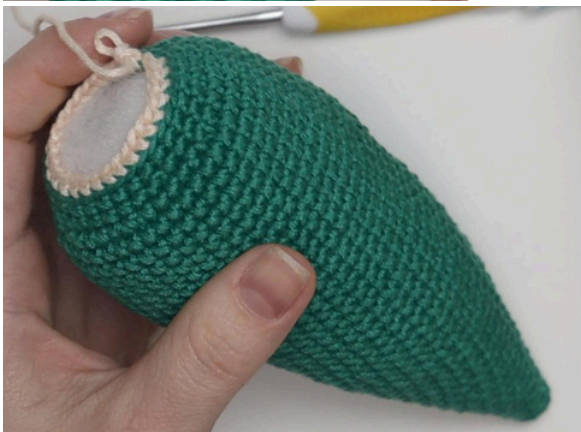

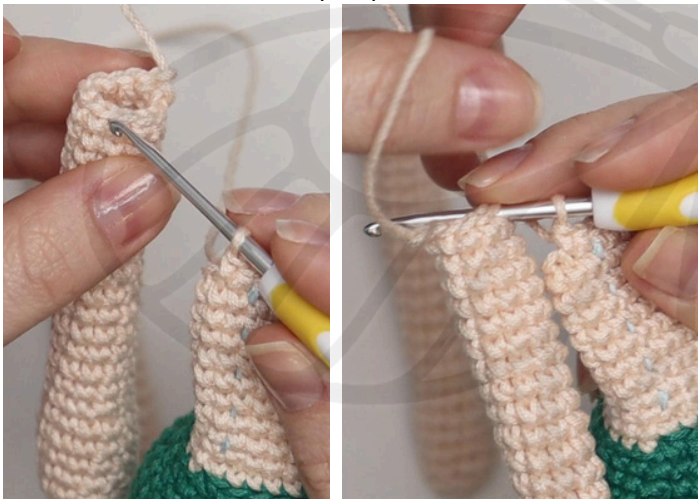

Note: Before you continue, fill and make sure that the support you are going to place, in this case the silicone tube, has a point created to make it easier to insert it and also enter easily, remember that the more filling you place, the more support it will give to the silicone tube and in turn to the body, if you wish you can bring the tip to the lower part of the tail, but then you will not be able to bend the tail in the future.



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Note: I suggest you just make sure the silicone tube enters the body and remove it to continue crocheting more comfortably, then before stuffing the head then reinsert it, but this is just for comfort, you can actually leave it in already and continue with the head

R63: 10sc, 1inc (12)

Place the eyes between R78 and 79 with 13 stitches apart, the 1st eye between stitches 24 and 25, 2nd eye between points 37 and 38

Note: If putting them between the exact points mentioned above will not center the eyes, please just take into account the turns and the separation, this can be caused by no one knitting exactly the same or you are using the V-shaped sc, just make them as center as possible



R83: (10sc, 1dec)x6 (66)

R84-86: 66sc

R87: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60)



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R88: 3sc, 1dec, (8sc, 1dec)x5, 5sc (54)

R89: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

R90: 3sc, 1dec, (6sc, 1dec)x5, 3sc (42)

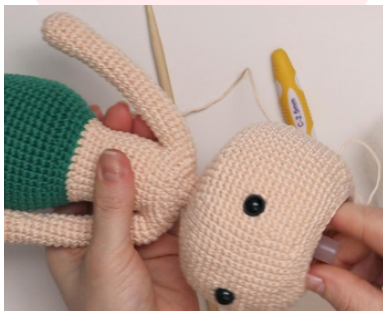

Note: Before continuing, place the silicone tube because the head will be closed more and more.

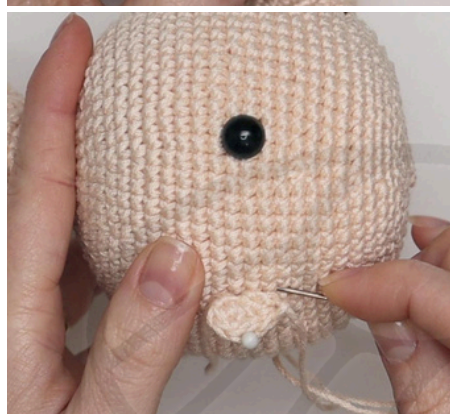




Leave a long tail to sew to the head 8 sc towards the side of each eye

R7: 2sc, 1inc, (5sc, 1inc)x5, 3sc (42)

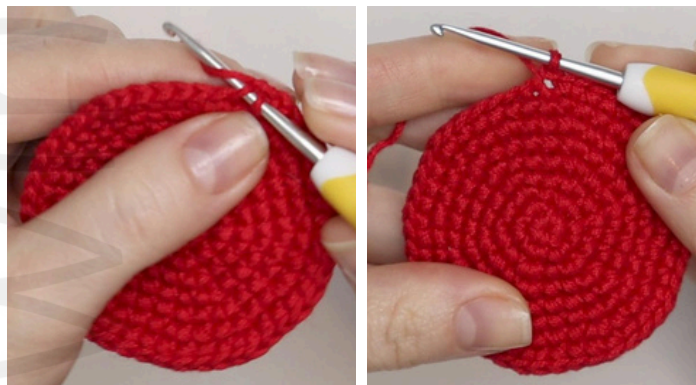

## Big locks (make 37)

1ss, BLO [54ch, in 3rd start (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x6, 40hdc, 1ss]x37

R2-9: 2ch, turn, skip 1sc, BLO 10sc, (at 2ch: 1sc, 2ch, 1sc), 10sc

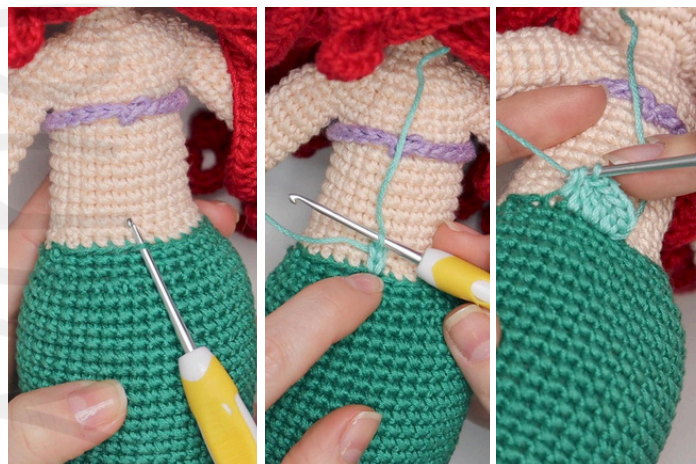
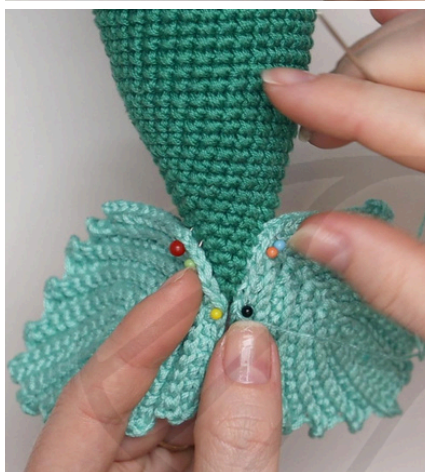
R10: 2ch, turn, skip 1sc, BLO 10sc, (at 2ch: 1inc), 10sc

### Ruffle at the waist

Use Strong Aqua color yarn

Note: You will notice this slight separation in the color change of the waist, do not worry, you will hardly see it

Start at point #6 counting from where I show you, 2ch, at the same point start (1dc, 1dc inc)x5, 1dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1ss, 1sc, 1hdc, (1dc, 1dc inc)x6, 1ss in the 1st dc for the round
