This amigurumi is worked with well-adjusted  
stitches and for the most part in a spiral  
shape, it is not necessary to close each round  
unless told to do so, you need to be careful  
and always mark the beginning of each  
round. It is necessary to read the entire  
pattern before beginning.

amigurumi.

## Bowser measures approximately 20cm tall and 15cm at its widest part

### Materials:

- Sinfonia Yarn, 100% Mercerized Cotton yarn, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Pumpkin 870 (Orange), Leaf Green 840 (35g), Mango (Yellow) 820 (20g), Wheat 862, Granate 823 (intense red), White 801, Tobacco 888 (brown).
- 2.5mm hook for Sinfonia yarn
- Eulali yarn, measures approximately 1mm thick, colors: Steel C-94 and White C-1
- 1.40mm hook for Eulali yarn
- Wool Needle
- temporary mark
- Scissors
- stuffing for amigurumi
- pins
- silicone (glue)
- Red and White Felt
- 6mm safety eyes

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thicker or smaller thread and depending on this thread will be the hook number.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.

### Abbreviations:

- A: Round
- ch: chain
- MR: Magic Ring
- sc: single crochet
- dec: decrease (close 2sc together)
- inc: Increase (2 sc in 1 stitch)
- dc: double crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- ss: slip stitch
- FLO: Front Loop Only (take only the front loop)
- BLO: Back Loop Only (take only the back loop)





## Legs (x2)

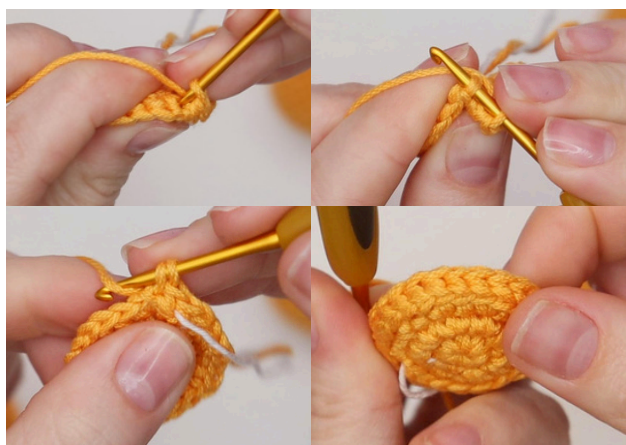
Use pumpkin colored yarn (Orange)

R1: MR 8sc

R2: 8inc (16)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x8 (24)

R4: 24sc reverse

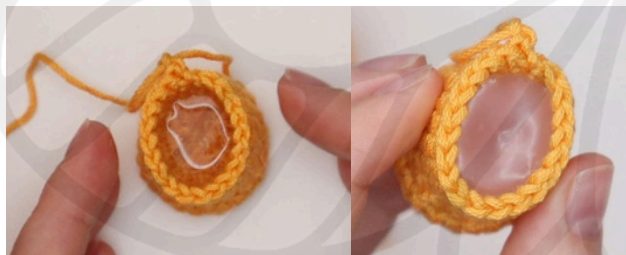
R5: 24sc

R6: 8sc, (1dec, 1sc)x2, 1dec, 8sc (21)

R7: 1dec, 19sc (20)

R8-11: 20sc

Note: It is necessary to place the piece on a flat surface, accommodate the fabric to it and then melt the silicone when it is at a very hot temperature. In the lower part, the fabric will remain flat and in the upper part, achieve that oval shape by holding on each side, once the silicone cools and hardens, it will remain so.

R12: FLO 2inc, 5sc, FLO 6inc, 5sc, FLO 2inc (30)

R13: 12sc, 6inc, 12sc (36)

R14-18: 36sc

R19: 14sc, 4dec, 14sc (32)

R20: 1dec, 28sc, 1dec (30)

R21: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24)

R22: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

R23: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R24: 12sc

Close each piece using a wool needle.

## Fingers (x8)

Use pumpkin colored yarn (Orange)

R1: MR 6sc

R2-3: 6sc

Note: Cut the thread at the end of the first 3 fingers that you make for each hand, when you make finger #4 of each hand, the union and formation of the arm will continue

R4: 3sc, on another finger 3sc, on another 6sc, on the next finger 3sc, 3sc more on the finger where we started this union (18)

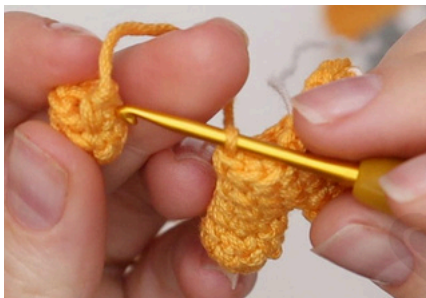

Note: The remaining strands after being safe may be part of the filling

R5-6: 18sc

R7: 9sc, 6sc on the 4th finger, 9sc (24)

R9: (6sc, 1dec)x3 (21)

R10-16: 21sc

R17: Join with 10sc, before closing completely place the filling.

Note: It is necessary to enter the link that we share for this union and the next round.

R18: FLO 10sc, BLO 11sc (21)

R19-30: 21sc

R31: Join with 10sc, 1ch to secure, before closing completely, place the filling.  
Leave a long strand to join the body late

### Claws (x14)

Note: 6 hooves for the legs and 8 for the arms

Use 1mm thick wire in Steel color with a 1.40mm hook (I have used Eulali)

- R1: MR 4sc
- R2: (1sc, 1inc)x2 (6)
- R3: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)
- R4: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)



Close using a wool needle (see the link)

Note: The union of each hoof will be made using hot silicone glue (it could also be with seams)

When doing it with silicone glue, it will also be filled.

Before gluing each one, with something pointed it will help its shape.

## handles (x4)

Using 1mm thick Steel color thread with 1.40mm hook (or the hook you prefer)

R1: 5ch, in the 2nd start 4sc (4)

R2-32: turn, 4sc (4)

1ch to fasten, leave the tail long to attach to the arm. (see link)

## White tips of the handles (x28)

Use 1mm thick thread and 1.40mm hook (or the hook you prefer)

MR 5sc and close with a wool needle, we will join it with glue (see link)

Use pumpkin colored yarn (orange)

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R6: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R7: (5sc, 1inc)x6 (42)

R8: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48)

R9: (7sc, 1inc)x6 (54)

R10: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60)

R11: (9sc, 1inc)x6 (66)

R12-22: 66sc

R23: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60)

R24-25: 60sc

Between Rounds 21 and 22 it will be the reference for the union with the legs.

R27-29: 54sc

R30: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

R31: 48sc

R32: (6sc, 1dec)x6 (42)

R33: 42sc

R34: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

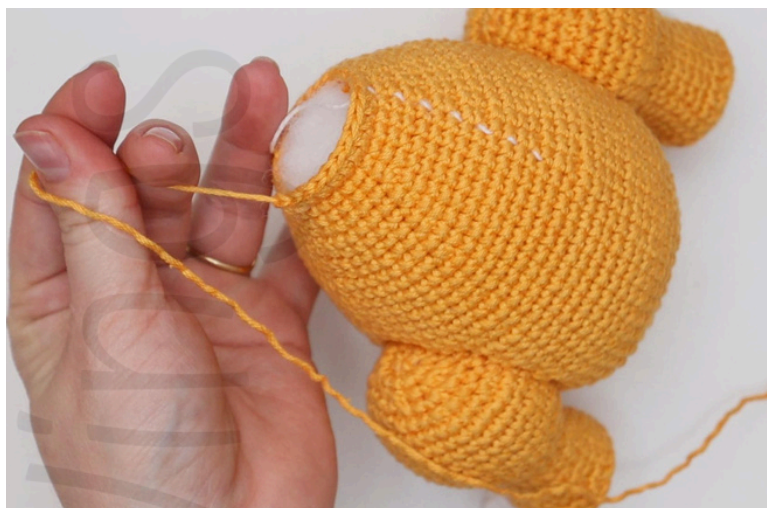

R36: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

R37-38: 30sc

R39: 10hdc, 1sc

Cut the strand leaving it long and then join to the head. Fill when finishing the body although before completing the union with the head it will be necessary to fill more

## Head

Use leaf green color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R6-7: 30sc

R8: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R9: 2sc, 1inc, (5sc, 1inc)x5, 3sc (42)

R10-17: 42sc

R18: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

R19: 36sc

R20: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

R21-22: 30sc

R23: 10hdc, 1sc, 1ch to secure.

Cut the strand (you don't need it long).

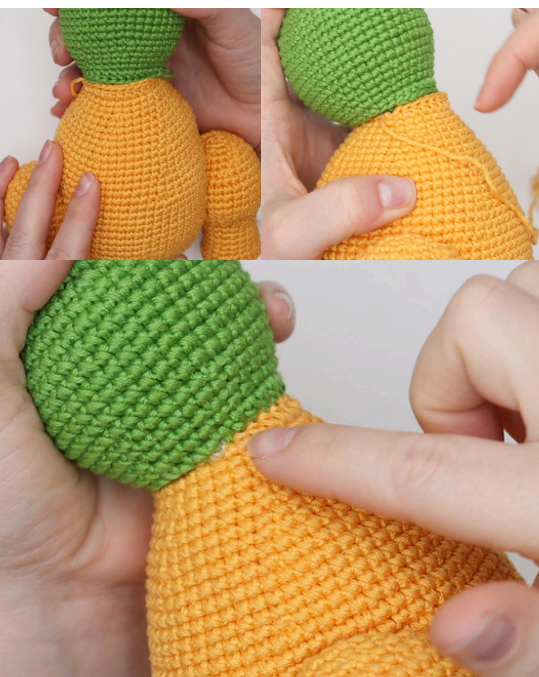
Fill when finishing the head although before completing the union with the body it will be necessary to fill more.

Note: Join the head to the body in such a way that the highest points coordinate together in the back, in this way it will be possible to tilt forward, for this union it is necessary to enter the link that we share

This union does not need to be perfect because this amigurumi will also have a necklace (see video)

Note: For the union of the arms it is necessary to embrace your belly and keep in mind that the 4th finger that joined the arm is facing up. (watch video)

### Necklace

Use 1mm thick wire in the color Steel with a 1.40mm hook (or the hook you prefer)  
R1: 5ch , in the 2nd start 4sc (4)  
R2-48: turn, 4sc (4) 1ch to secure.  
Leave the yarn long to join the neck.

Note: This union is the same as the union of the bracelets on the arms, as well as gluing the following points

White Tips (x10) (or less)  
1mm thick thread and 1.40mm hook  
MR 5sc and close with a yarn needle, we will join it with glue (see video)

Use Pumpkin color yarn (orange)

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: 8sc

R4: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R5: (4sc, 1inc)x2 (12)

R6: (3sc, 1inc)x3 (15)

R7: 15sc

R8: (4sc, 1inc)x3 (18)

R9-10: 18sc

R11: (5sc, 1inc)x3 (21)

R12: 21sc

R13: (6sc, 1inc)x3 (24)

R14: 24sc

R15: (7sc, 1inc)x3 (27)

R16: 27sc

R17-18: 2hdc, 10dc, 2hdc, 13ss (27)

Note: The 13sd of the R18 will be done in the same center of the sd of the previous round.

1c to fasten, cut the strand and leave it long to join the body. (watch video)

## Shell

Use leaf green color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: 1sc, 1inc, (3sc, 1inc)x5, 2sc (30)

R6: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R7: 2sc, 1inc, (5sc, 1inc)x5, 3sc (42)

R8: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48)

R9: 3sc, 1inc, (7sc, 1inc)x5, 4sc (54)

R10: 54sc

R11: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60)

R12: 4sc, 1inc, (9sc, 1inc)x5, 5sc (66)

R13: 66sc

R14: (10sc, 1inc)x6 (72)

R15-17: 72sc

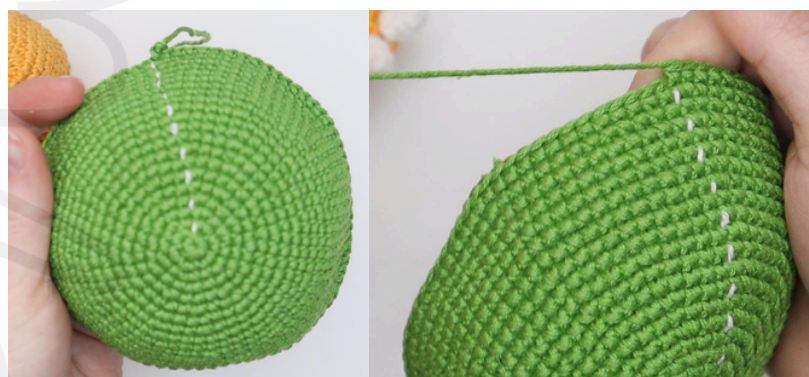
R18: (11sc, 1inc)x6 (78)

R19: 78sc

R20: (12sc, 1inc)x6 (84)

R21: 84sc

You do not need to leave the tail long unless you prefer to sew with it.

## Shell Points (x11)

One of them is for the tail

Use mango color thread (Yellow)

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R4: (4sc, 1inc)x2 (12)

R5: (5sc, 1inc)x2 (14)

R6: (6sc, 1inc)x2 (16)

Cast off using a tapestry needle, it is not necessary to leave the tail end long unless you prefer to sew with it. (watch video)

## Small tip of the tail (x1)

Use mango color yarn (Yellow)

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R4: (4sc, 1inc)x2 (12)

Closure with wool needle  
(see video)



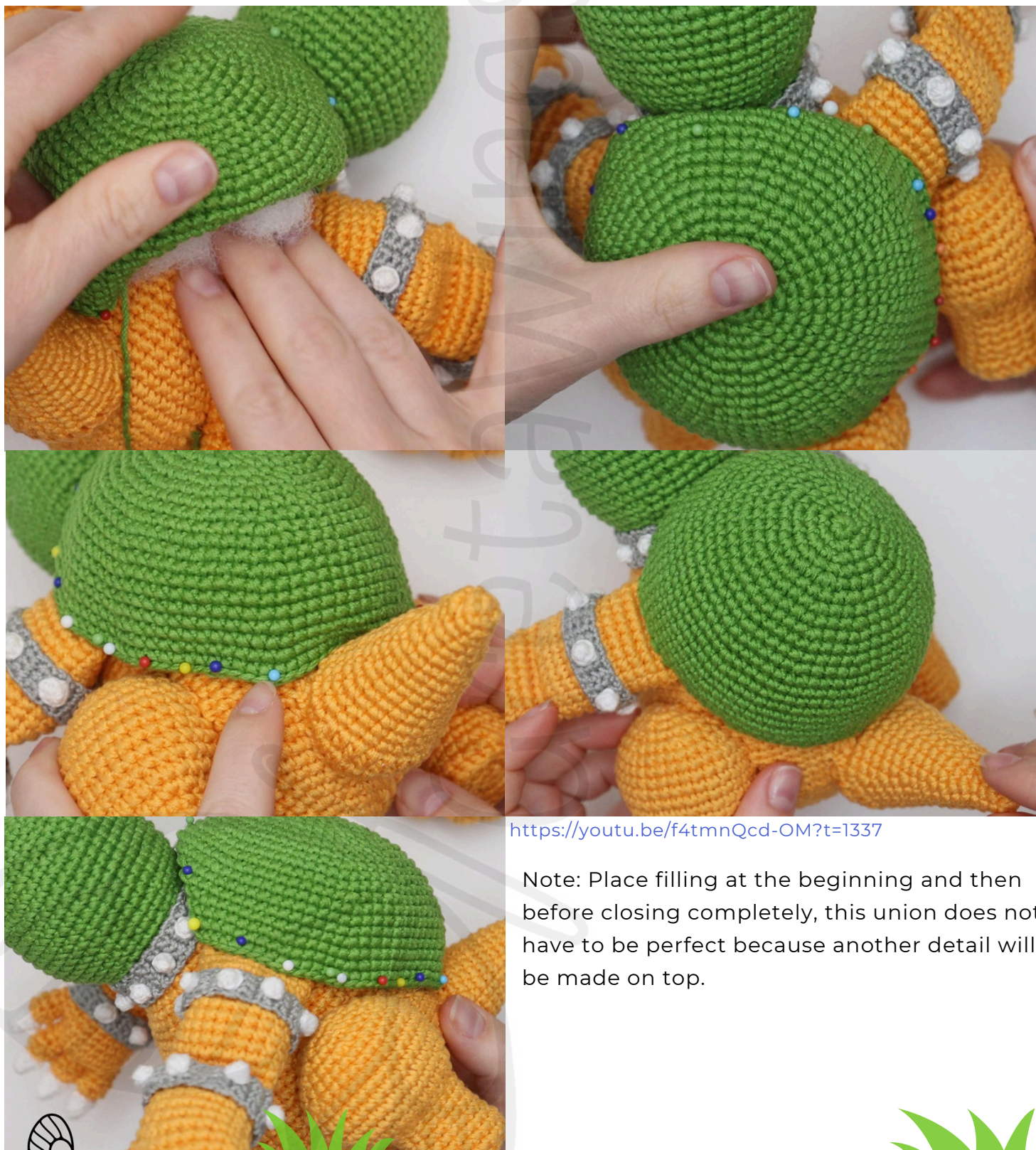
Note: This smaller tip is the same as the previous ones from R1-4.

Note: Place filling at the beginning and then before closing completely, this union does not have to be perfect because another detail will be made on top.





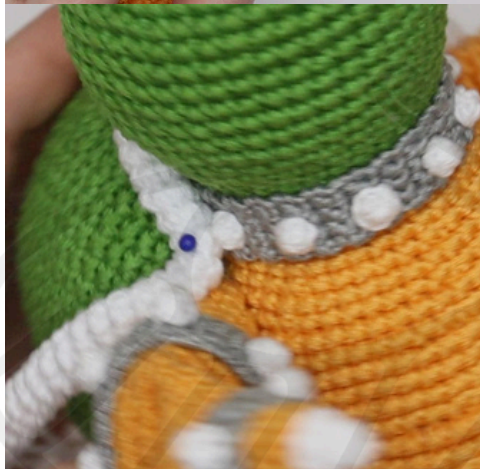
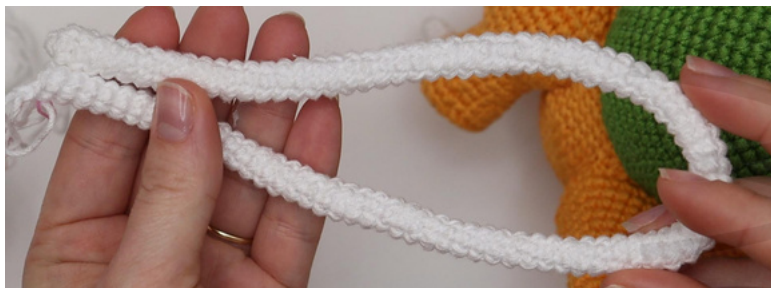
## White rib for the shell

R1: MR 6sc

R2-90: 6sc

Leave the long strand for the closure with the other end. Pay close attention to the union to the body, if necessary watch the video

## Belly

Use wheat colored yarn

R1: 9ch, in the 2nd start 8sc (8)

R2: 1ch, turn, BLO 1inc, 6sc, 1inc (10)

R3: 1ch, turn, BLO 10sc (10)

R4: 1ch, turn, BLO 1inc, 8sc, 1inc (12)

R5: 1ch, turn, BLO 12sc (12)

R6: 1ch, turn, BLO 1inc, 10sc, 1inc (14)

R7: 1ch, turn, BLO 14sc (14)

R8: 1ch, turn, BLO 1inc, 12sc, 1inc (16)

R9-18: 1ch, turn, BLO 16sc (16)

R19: 1ch, turn, BLO 1dec, 12sc, 1dec (14)

R20: 1ch, turn, BLO 2sc, 10hdc, 2sc, 1c to secure

Note: Add as many pins as necessary to then sew using a wool needle.

## Mouth

Use wheat colored yarn

Bottom piece (x1)

R1: MR 6sc

R2-3: 6sc

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R5-10: 8sc

R11: 8inc (16)

R12-20: 16sc

R21: 8dec (8)

Note: When finishing R8 it is necessary to fill in only one side that will be the lower lip of the mouth, then sew the other side that will be the inside of the mouth (see link)

R22-27: 8sc

R28: (2sc, 1dec)x2 (6)

R29-31: 6sc

Close with a knitting needle. (see link)

Top piece (x2)

Use wheat colored yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (5sc, 1inc)x2 (14)

R4-5: 14sc

R6: (5sc, 1dec)x2 (12)

R7: (1sc, 1dec)x4 (8)

R8-9: 8sc

R10: (1sc, 1inc)x4 (12)

R11: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R12-16: 18sc

R17: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R18: 12sc

Fill only a little, that it is possible to flatten it as in the image and close using wool.

Center piece (x1)

Use wheat colored yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R4: (4sc, 1inc)x2 (12)

R5-9: 12sc

R10: 5sc joining, 1ch to secure

Note: This piece does not need filling.

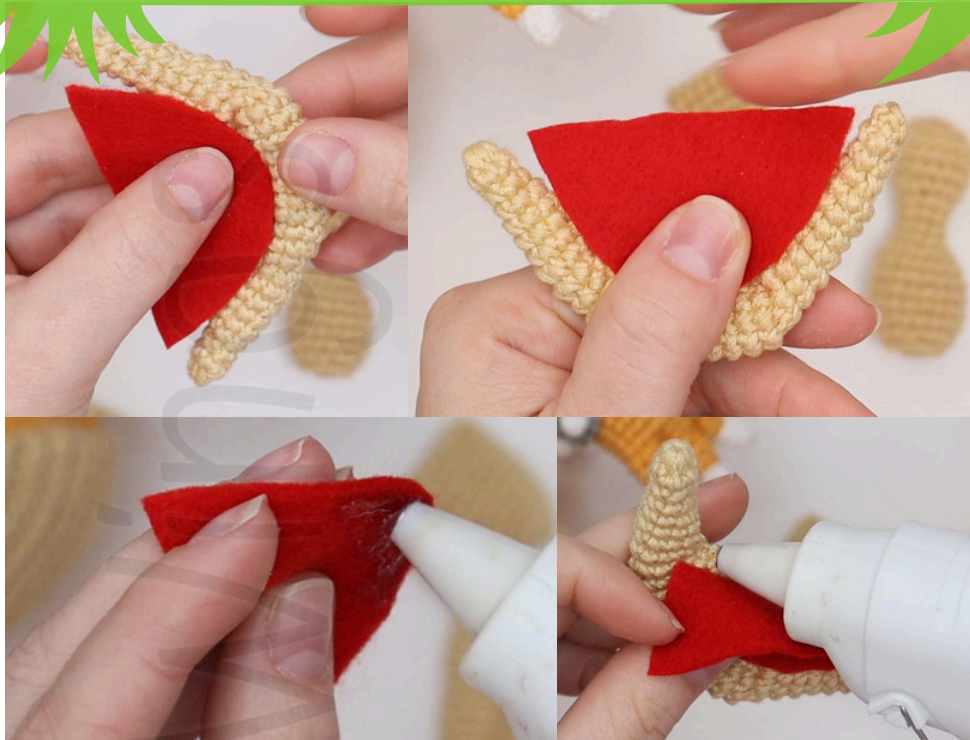






Cut red felt in the same shape inside the bottom lip.  
Paste it as shown in the images and then continue with the union of the mouth (see link)

Glue the  
loose filter  
to the head



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To mark the holes of the Snout, it is necessary to use a woolen needle and tobacco-colored thread (brown), two stitches in each one (see link)

Use 1mm thick white thread and 1.40mm hook

R1: MR 4sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x2 (6)

Close with a yarn needle and stick to the lips using silicone glue. (see link)

R3: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R5: (5sc, 1inc)x2 (14)

R6-9: 14sc

R10: 6sc joining, 1c to secure

Cut the strand and hide it

Medium Pieces (x3)

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R4: (4sc, 1inc)x2 (12)

R5: (5sc, 1inc)x2 (14)

R6-7: 14sc

R8: 6sc joining, 1c to secure

Cut the strand and hide it

Utilizar hilo color Mango (Amarillo)

Use Mango color yarn (Yellow)

R1: MR 4sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x2 (6)

R3: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R4: 3sc, 2ss, 3sc (8)

R5: 3sc, FLO 2sc, 3sc (8)

R6: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R7: (4sc, 1inc)x2 (12)

R8: (2sc, 1inc)x4 (16)

Large Pieces (x2)

8ch, in the 2nd start BLO 2ss, 1sc, 1hdc inc, 1sc, 2ss

Small Pieces (x2)

6ch, in the 2nd start BLO 1ss, 1sc, 1inc, 1sc, 1ss
