#### Important note:

This amigurumi is worked with well-adjusted stitches and for the most part in a spiral shape, it is not necessary to close each round unless told to do so, you need to be careful and always mark the beginning of each round. It is necessary to read the entire pattern before beginning.

## Peach is approximately 31cm tall.

#### Materials:

- Sinfonia yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Flesh or skin 890 (70g), White 801, Tobacco 888, Mango 820 (Yellow) (50g), Pink 864 (40), Coral 883.
- 2.5mm hook for Sinfonía yarn
- Eulali yarn, measures approximately 1mm thick, colors: Red, jade (Blue) and Yellow.
- 1.60mm hook for Eulali yarn
- wOOL Needle
- Scissors
- 10mm safety eyes
- temporary mark
- pins
- Silicon (full size glue stick)
- stuffing for amigurumi

#### **Abbreviations:**

- R: Round
- ch: chain stitch
- MR: Magic ring
- sc: single crochet
- dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)
- inc: Increase (2sc in 1 stitch)
- dc: double crochet
- · hdc: half double crochet
- ss: Slip stitch
- FLO: Front Loop Only (take only the front strand)
- BLO: Back Loop Only (take only the back strand)

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thicker or smaller thread and depending on this thread will be the hook number.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.


#### Arms (x2)

### Detail with white color yarn

Start at the back (see link if necessary) FLO (2ch, 4hdc, 2ch, 1ss)x2

## Legs (x2)

Start with flesh-colored yarn or whatever you have chosen for the skin.

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10)

Note: It is necessary to mark Chain number 4 before beginning to make the first single crochet, because for the second triple inc, just in that 4th chain will be made



R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

R4: BLO 24sc



R5-7: 24sc

Note: Before continuing it is necessary to fill the plant with silicone glue, the video shows this technique to achieve greater support, it can also be done by recycling a piece of plastic

R8: 6dec, 12sc (18)

R9: 18sc

R10: 3dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (14)

R11-30: 14sc

Cut the yarn at the end of the first leg and at the end of the second leg change to White yarn in the last single crochet of R30 to start the underwear



Make the ears 8 points apart from each eye In their points they will be the same, the different thing will be where to start each one

1ch, 1sc, 5hdc at the same point, 1sc, 1ss (watch video)

#### Crown

Use gold or gold colored thread R1: 32ch, in the 1st start, 32sc (32)

Note: To start the 1st of the 32sc, insert the hook where it is easiest, at the same time secure the beginning strand.

R4: skeep 4 points (fan: 4dc, 3ch, 1ss, 4dc), skeep 3 points, 1ss, [skeep 3 points, (fan: 4dc, 3ch, 1ss, 4dc), skeep 3 points, 1ss]x2, skeep 3 points, (fan: 4dc, 3ch, 1ss, 4dc), skeep 4 points, 1ss

Note: cut the yarn, leaving enough yarn to pass behind it, secure it and hide it Stones (x4) 2 blue and 2 red

Use 1mm thick thread and 1.60mm hook MR (3hdc, 1sc)x2

When finished, leave a long tail to close with a yarn needle and then join to the crown (see video)

### Earrings or Earrings

Use 1mm thick Jade thread (it is blue) and 1.60mm hook

R1: MR 6sc (6)

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: 8sc

R4: (2sc, 1dec)x2 (6)

R5: 3dec (3)

Close with a wool needle and leave the yarn to

join the ears. (watch video)

#### Dress

Start with Pink color yarn

R1: 30ch, in the 7th start (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

Note: By mistake in the video it is mentioned to finish this round with 24 stitches, the correct one is 30 without counting the chains for the

buttonhole.

R2: turn, (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

Note: Start at the 1st hole left after turning



R1: 1ch, 1sc at the same point, (2hdc, 1hdc inc)x4, 1sc, 1ss (18)

R2: 1ch, 1sc, (3hdc, 1hdc inc)x4, 1sc, 1ss (22)

R3: 1ch, 1sc, 20hdc, 1sc, 1ss (22)

R4: 1ch, 5sc, (1hdc, 1hdc dec)x4, 5sc, 1ss (18)

R5: 18ss

#### Dress neck

Use coral colore yarn

R1: 1ch, on the same base start 24sc (24) Note: Start this round from the back and inside the dress, as shown in the image.



#### Dress center stone

I have used thread of 1mm thick and hook 1.60mm

With yellow color yarn MR (1hdc, 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc)x2 Close with a wool needle https://youtu.be/KT4G6I4Pdf0? t=1815

With jade color yarn
MR (3hdc, 1sc)x2
Cut leaving a long tail to close with a wool
needle and then join to the previous piece

# Shoes (x2)

Use coral color yarn.

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10) Note: This R1 is the same as the R1 of the legs.

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16) R3: (2sc, 6inc)x2 (28)

R4: 28sc reverse

R5-8: 28sc

R9: 2sc. 6dec, 14sc (22)

R10: turn, 12sc(12)

Note: Up to R10 both shoes will be exactly the same, at the end of the first up to R10 continue with R11 that corresponds to the left Shoe and then the second will continue with R11 that corresponds to the right shoe

#### Left shoe

R11: 25ch, turn, 12sc beginning in the last sc of the previous R, 13sc.


### Right shoe

R11: turn, 12sc, 25ch, 1sc at the base of the last sc we made, 12sc.
