Use Mango Yellow color yarn

R1: MR 6sc R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18) R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24) R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)



Continue with the locks

Locks #1-20: (51ch, in the 2nd start, BLO 50hdc, 1ss)x20







Lock #21: 25ch, in the 2nd start, BLO 24hdc, 1ss



Locks #22-23: (17ch, in the 2nd start, BLO 16hdc, lss)x2

Locks #28-29: (17ch,in the 2nd start, BLO 16hdc, lss)x2













Note: Hair can be sewn or glued, as you prefer

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Crown

Use gold or gold colored thread R1: 32ch, in the 1st start, 32sc (32)

Note: To start the 1st of the 32sc, insert the hook where it is easiest, at the same time secure the beginning strand.

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R2-3: 32sc



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R4: skeep 4 points (fan: 4dc, 3ch, 1ss, 4dc), skeep 3 points, 1ss, [skeep 3 points, (fan: 4dc, 3ch, 1ss, 4dc), skeep 3 points, 1ss]x2, skeep 3 points, (fan: 4dc, 3ch, 1ss, 4dc), skeep 4 points, 1ss

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Note: cut the yarn, leaving enough yarn to pass behind it, secure it and hide it

Stones (x4) 2 blue and 2 red Use 1mm thick thread and 1.60mm hook MR (3hdc, 1sc)x2

When finished, leave a long tail to close with a yarn needle and then join to the crown (see video)



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Note: Attach to the head using only two strands of the same thread and yarn needle, the diameter of the crown matches that of the top of the hair.

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Earrings or Earrings

Use 1mm thick Jade thread (it is blue) and

1.60mm hook

R1: MR 6sc (6)

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: 8sc

R4: (2sc, 1dec)x2 (6)

R5: 3dec (3)

Close with a wool needle and leave the yarn to

join the ears. (watch video)

Dress

Start with Pink color yarn

R1: 30ch, in the 7th start (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

Note: By mistake in the video it is mentioned to finish this round with 24 stitches, the correct one is 30 without counting the chains for the

buttonhole.

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R2: turn, (4sc, linc)x6 (36)

Note: Start at the 1st hole left after turning





R3: turn, (5sc, linc)x6 (42)

R4: turn, 42sc



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R5: turn, [6sc, (inc: 1hdc, 1dc), 2ch, skeep 10 points, (inc: 1dc, 1hdc)]x2, 6sc (30)




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R6-11: turn, 30sc (30)



R12: 1ch, turnr, BLO 30hdc inc (60) R13: 1ch, 60hdc, 1ss (60)

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R27: 1ch, BLO 60hdc(60)

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Note: Close with a wool needle and it will be less noticeable where the fabric has finished.

Sleeves (x2)

Use pink color yarn

Note: Both sleeves will be the same, just change where each one starts.



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R1: 1ch, 1sc at the same point, (2hdc, 1hdc inc)x4, 1sc, 1ss (18)



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Note: The 1st hdc begins on the dress hdc inc, then the 4th hdc inc is done at the base of the next dress inc.

R2: 1ch, 1sc, (3hdc, 1hdc inc)x4, 1sc, 1ss (22)

R3: 1ch, 1sc, 20hdc, 1sc, 1ss (22)

R4: 1ch, 5sc, (1hdc, 1hdc dec)x4, 5sc, 1ss (18)

R5: 18ss

Note: Close using a wool needle (see video if necessary



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Dress neck

Use coral colore yarn

R1: 1ch, on the same base start 24sc (24) Note: Start this round from the back and inside the dress, as shown in the image.

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Dress details (x2)


Use coral colore yarn

R1: MR 12hdc (12)



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R2: 1ch, turn, (3hdc, 1hdc inc)x3 (15)



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R3: 1ch, turn, (4hdc, 1hdc inc)x3 (18)

R4: 1ch, turn, (5hdc, 1hdc inc)x3 (21)

R5: 1ch, turn, (6hdc, 1hdc inc)x3 (24)

R6: turn, 24ss



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Note: For a better understanding about the following union it is necessary to watch the video

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Dress center stone

I have used thread of 1mm thick and hook 1.60mm

With yellow color yarn MR (1hdc, 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc)x2 Close with a wool needle https://youtu.be/Rx6thMErCPc?t=1753

With jade color yarn
MR (3hdc, 1sc)x2
Cut leaving a long tail to close with a wool
needle and then join to the previous piece



Join centered on the front of the dress



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Place Button (the color you prefer), the size depending on the buttonhole, using a strand of yellow thread

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Shoes (x2)

Use coral color yarn.

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10) Note: This R1 is the same as the R1 of the legs.

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16) R3: (2sc, 6inc)x2 (28)

R4: 28sc reverse

R5-8: 28sc

R9: 2sc. 6dec, 14sc (22)

R10: turn, 12sc(12)

Note: Up to R10 both shoes will be exactly the same, at the end of the first up to R10 continue with R11 that corresponds to the left Shoe and then the second will continue with R11 that corresponds to the right shoe

Left shoe

R11: 25ch, turn, 12sc beginning in the last sc of the previous R, 13sc.

Right shoe

R11: turn, 12sc, 25ch, 1sc at the base of the last sc we made, 12sc.
