# This base body for LoL Dolls measures approximately 10 inches (25.4cm)

#### Materials:

- Sinfonía yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Flesh or Skin 890, Mexican Pink 825, Strong Aqua 831, Mango Yellow 820, White 801, Jacaranda (Blue) 815, With 2.5mm Hook
- Eulali yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 1mm thick and has 4 strands.
   Colors: White C-1, Black C-99, Light Tobacco C-25 and Yellow C-4. With 1.60mm Hook
- La Abuelita Yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 1mm thick and has 6 strands. Color: Pink (for the mouth) With 1.60mm Hook
- Yarn Needle
- temporary bookmark
- Scissors
- stuffing for amigurumi
- pins
- Silicone tube, 1cm diameter and 12cm long
- hot silicone glue

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thicker or smaller thread and depending on this thread will be the hook number. In the same way, you will choose, you must take into account the size of your eyes.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I do. by designing it for you.

R: Ronda
ch: chain
MR: Magic Ring
ss: slip stiches
sc: single crochet
dc: double crochet
hdc: half double crochet
dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)
inc: increase (2sc in 1stiche)
triple inc: increase (3sc in 1stiche)



# Arms (x2)

Use flesh or skin color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9)

R3: 9sc

R4: 4sc, (Ispeck point: 4hdc in the same place and closed together), 4sc (9)

R5: 9sc

R6: FLO (2sc, 1incx3 (12)

R7-9: 12sc

R10: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10)

R11-16: 10sc

Cut the strand, no length is needed, these arms will join the body seamlessly. Fill, just enough for you to take yourform, but not too much if you want them flexible

# Legs (x2)

Start using flesh or skin color yarn R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start, (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10)


R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

R4: BLO 24sc R5-6: 24sc

Note: When finishing the R6 it is necessary to fill the feet with silicone or recycle plastic, in this way the result is flatter. In case of using melted silicone, it is advisable to make both legs up to R6 and fill them both at the same time. (see link for better understanding)

R7: 4sc, 4dec, 6sc, 2dec, 2sc (18)

R8-14: 18sc

R15: 4sc, FLO 4sc, 4sc, 3dec (15)

R16: 5sc, 2inc, 5sc, 3inc (20)

R17-23: 20sc



Note: At the end of the first leg, cut the yarn over, to finish the second one, in the last single crochet of Round 23 change to Mexican pink thread and do not cut the yarn over to continue with the next round and join the legs.

R24: La Union using Mexican pink color yarn, 4sc, 2ch, 20sc on the other free leg, 2sc in the 2ch, 16sc on the starting leg (44)

Note: Both legs must be straight, see the video in case the same points do not make it.

R32: 32sc Change to flesh or skin colored yarn

in the last single crochet of this round.

R37: Union of Arms 12sc, 10sc in one arm, 14sc,

10sc in another arm, 2sc (48)

Use flesh or skin color yarn

Leave a long strand at the beginning before

making the magic ring

R1: MR 5sc

R2: turn, 1sc, 3hdc inc, 1sc (8)

Leave a long strand for joining the head.

## Eyes (x2)

Eulali yarn (1mm thick yarn)

Hook 1.60mm

Start using black color yarn

R1: MR 8sc R2: 8inc (16)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x8 (24)

Note: Do not cut the yarn, make I chain as a fastener for the moment, then more rounds will be done with this yarn.

R4: Using Light Tobacco color yarn, begin in the 3rd slipped stitch of R3.

BLO pulls out a loop, in the next slip stitch begins, 15ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R5: Continue using light tobacco yarn, Start at the 2nd slip stitch of R4.

BLO pulls out a loop, in the next slipped stitch begin, 2sc, (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x3, 1hdc, 2sc, 1ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R6: Undo the chain that was made at the end of R3.

BLO 27ss

Note: Do not cut the yarn, make 1 chain as a fastener for the moment, then more rounds will be done with this yarn.

## Mouth

La Abuelita yarn Imm thick, hook 1.60mm

MR 2sc, 3hdc, 5sc, 1ch, 1hdc, 1ch, 1ss, 1ch, 1hdc, 1ch, 3sc

Close with a wool needle and leave the long tail to join the face later.

R7: Using White color yarn, begin at the 5th slipped stitch of R6.

BLO pulls out a loop, in the next slip stitch begins, 13ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R8: Continue using white color yarn, Start at the 1st slipped stitch of R7.

BLO pulls out a loop, beginning in the next slipped stitch, 2sc, (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x3, 2sc, 1ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R9: Undo the chain that was made at the end of R3.

BLO 30ss

Cut the thread leaving enough to close using a wool needle and also for the union with the face, embroidery of eyebrows and eyelashes.



# Shoes (x2)

Begin using White yarn and a slipknot.

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10)

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24) R4: 5sc, 4inc, 8sc, 4inc, 3sc (32)

R5: 32sc reverse (32)

Cut the strand leaving it alone to secure it and hide it later.

## Front piece

Use white yarn and start at the 4th stitch of the previous Round

R1: draw a loop, 1ch, at the same base start

12sc (12)

R2: turn 12sc (12)

R3: 3ch, turn, 12dc closed together.

Note: make sure you have 13 strands on the hook, take a yarn over and pass it through the 13 strands, 1 c to close, cut the yarn leaving enough to secure this closure very well using a yarn needle.

#### Pieza trasera

rear piece

Use Mexican pink thread and start at the same base of the single crochet number 12 of the 1st round of the previous piece.

R1: draw a loop, 1ch, at the same base start 22sc (22)

Note: The last single crochet will be made at the base of the 1st sc of the R1 of the previous piece. At the same time secure the strand that has become free.

Use Mexican pink yarn and start with 1 slipknot.

R1: 7ch, in the 2nd start 6sc (6)

R2-10: turn, 6sc (6)

R11: turn, linc, 4sc, linc (8)

Ich to fasten, cut the strand leaving enough to hide it.



# Paint drops with Mexican pink thread starting with Islipknot.

10ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 2hdc, 3sc 14ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 2hdc, 5sc 11ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 2hdc, 4sc, 2ch Repeat the same sequence as many times as necessary until reaching the full width of the start of the yellow mango frill.

We have repeated it a total of 5 times but it depends a lot on each crochet

7ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc
7ch, in the 3rd start 2hdc, 1sc
10ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 2hdc, 1sc
Repeat the same sequence as many times as necessary to achieve the full width of the beginning of the Mexican pink ruffle.

We have repeated it a total of 5 times but it depends a lot on each crochet

10ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 2hdc, 2sc, 1ss
8ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1ss.
1ch to secure and cut yarn over leaving enough yarn to hide it.

1ch to secure and hide strands.

1ch to secure and hide strands.

Use Jacaranda color yarn(Other blue)

Start with 1slipknot

R1: 13ch, in the 2nd start 12sc (12)

R2-50: turn, 12sc (12)

1ch to fasten, cut the strand leaving enough

strand to join both ends.

#### Center

Use Jacaranda color yarn (Other blue)

Start with Islipknot

R1: 5ch, in the 2nd start 4sc (4)

R2-14: turn, 4sc (4)

1ch to fasten, cut the strand leaving the strand long enough to join both ends hugging the previous loop.





# Paint drops for the bow

Use Hilaza Eulali, (1mm thick) of yellow color.

Start with 1slip knot

13ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 2hdc, 2sc, 4ss

10ch, in the 4th start 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1ss, 2ch

Repeat the same sequence as many times as necessary to achieve the entire edge of the previous loop. We have repeated it a total of 9 times.
