This amigurumi is worked with welladjusted stitches and for the most part in a
spiral shape, do not close each round
unless I tell you to, you will have to be
careful and always mark the beginning of
each round. Please read the entire pattern
before beginning.

# This Amigurumi measures approximately 10 inches (25.4cm)

#### Materials:

- Sinfonía yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Tobacco 888, Gold 869, Black 803, With 2.5mm Hook
- Eulali yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 1mm thick and has 4 strands.
   Colors: White C-1, Black C-99, Light Tobacco C-25 and Yellow C-4. With 1.60mm Hook
- La Abuelita Yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 1mm thick and has 6 strands. Color: Pink (for the mouth) With 1.60mm Hook
- Gold super fine thread is optional.
- Wool Needle
- temporary mark
- Scissors
- stuffing for amigurumis
- pins
- Silicone tube, 1cm diameter and 12cm long
- hot silicone glue

Notes: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi bigger or smaller using a thicker or smaller thread and depending on this thread will be the hook number. In the same way, you will choose, you must take into account the size of your eyes.

The explanatory images and videos for the body will be seen with the flesh-colored yarns and the Mexican pink underwear, however for this LOL you will use the colors as indicated

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I do. by designing it for you.

#### Abbreviations:

R: Ronda ch: chain MR: Magic Ring

ss: slip stiches

sc: single crochet dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)

inc: increase (2sc in 1stiche)

triple inc: increase (3sc in 1stiche)





# Arms (x2)

Use Tabacco color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9)

R3: 9sc

R4: 4sc, (Ispeck point: 4hdc in the same place and closed together), 4sc (9)

R5: 9sc

R6: FLO (2sc, 1incx3 (12)

R7-9: 12sc

R10: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10)

R11-16: 10sc

Cut the strand, no length is needed, these arms will join the body seamlessly. Fill, just enough for you to take yourform, but not too much if you want them flexible

## Legs (x2)

Start using Tobacco color yarn

R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start, (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10)

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

R4: BLO 24sc

R5-6: 24sc

Note: When finishing the R6 it is necessary to fill the feet with silicone or recycle plastic, in this way the result is flatter. In case of using melted silicone, it is advisable to make both legs up to R6 and fill them both at the same time. (see link for better understanding)

R7: 4sc, 4dec, 6sc, 2dec, 2sc (18)

R8-14: 18sc

R15: 4sc, FLO 4sc, 4sc, 3dec (15)

R16: 5sc, 2inc, 5sc, 3inc (20)

R17-23: 20sc



Note: At the end of the first leg, cut the yarn over, to finish the second one, in the last single crochet of Round 23 change to gold and do not cut the yarn over to continue with the next round and join the legs.

R24: La Union using gold color yarn, 4sc, 2ch, 20sc on the other free leg, 2sc in the 2ch, 16sc on the starting leg (44)

Note: Both legs must be straight, see the video in case the same points do not make it.

R28: (9sc, 1dec)x4 (40)

R29-30: 40sc

R31: (3sc, 1dec)x8 (32)

R32: 32sc Change to Tobacco colored yarn in

the last single crochet of this round.

R33: (6sc, 1dec)x4 (28)

R34-36: 28sc

R37: Union of Arms 12sc, 10sc in one arm, 14sc,

10sc in another arm, 2sc (48)

Note: It is necessary that each little arm is facing forward, if it does not look like this, please watch the video.

Note: Fill each shoulder very well, but in the center keep it with little filling

Note: Using something sharp, create a hole to insert the silicone tube. Leave it or place it again later before completely closing the head

R67: (8sc, 1dec)x9 (81)

R68-69: 81sc

Note: Placing melted silicone around the silicone tube and a little on the bottom of the head will give more support. Fill the head although before closing it is necessary to place more and more filling. Also cut off excess silicone.

# Ears (x2)

Use Tobacco color yarn

Leave a long strand at the beginning before

making the magic ring

R1: MR 5sc

R2: turn, 1sc, 3hdc inc, 1sc (8)

Leave a long strand for joining the head.

## Eyes (x2)

Eulali yarn (1mm thick yarn)

Hook 1.60mm

Start using black color yarn

R1: MR 8sc R2: 8inc (16)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x8 (24)

Note: Do not cut the yarn, make I chain as a fastener for the moment, then more rounds will be done with this yarn.

R4: Using Light Tobacco color yarn, begin in the 3rd slipped stitch of R3.

BLO pulls out a loop, in the next slip stitch begins, 15ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R5: Continue using light tobacco yarn, Start at the 2nd slip stitch of R4.

BLO pulls out a loop, in the next slipped stitch begin, 2sc, (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x3, 1hdc, 2sc, 1ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R6: Undo the chain that was made at the end of R3.

BLO 27ss

Note: Do not cut the yarn, make I chain as a fastener for the moment, then more rounds will be done with this yarn.

## Mouth

La Abuelita yarn 1mm thick, hook 1.60mm

MR 2sc, 3hdc, 5sc, 1ch, 1hdc, 1ch, 1ss, 1ch, 1hdc, 1ch, 3sc

Close with a wool needle and leave the long tail to join the face later.

R7: Using White color yarn, begin at the 5th slipped stitch of R6.

BLO pulls out a loop, in the next slip stitch begins, 13ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R8: Continue using white color yarn, Start at the 1st slipped stitch of R7.

BLO pulls out a loop, beginning in the next slipped stitch, 2sc, (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x3, 2sc, 1ss. Cut the yarn over and pull it back towards the back at the same stitch as the last slipped stitch.

R9: Undo the chain that was made at the end of R3.

BLO 30ss

Cut the thread leaving enough to close using a wool needle and also for the union with the face, embroidery of eyebrows and eyelashes.



## Shoes (x2)

Use black yarn

R1: Start with a slipknot and then 4ch, in the 2nd


start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10)

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

R4: 5sc, 4inc, 8sc, 4inc, 3sc (32)

R8: (1sc, 1dec)x6, 6sc, 1dec, 6sc (25)

Cut the strand leaving enough to hide it.

## Front piece

R1: Start in the 3rd stitch of the previous R, BLO 1ch in the same base start 1sc, 6sc, BLO 1sc (8)


R2: turn, 1dec, 4sc, 1dec (6)

R3: turn, 6sc (6)

R4: turn, linc, 4sc, linc, 1ch to secure (8)

Cut the strand leaving enough to hide it.

# Back piece

Start in the 2nd front loop that we left free R1: FLO 1sc, 17sc, FLO 1sc (19) R2-3: turn, 19sc, 1ch to secure (19)

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#### Dress

Start with Gold or Gold colored thread R1: Start with 30cH, in the 7th start BLO 24sc (24) Change to black yarn.

R2: turn, 4sc, (inc: 1hdc,1dc), 5ch, skip 3st, (inc: 1dc,1hdc), 6sc, (inc: 1hdc,1dc), 5ch, skip 3st, (inc: 1dc,1hdc), 4sc (32)

R3: turn, 32sc (32) Change to Gold or gold yarn.

R7: 6ch, turn, (9sc, linc)x4 (44) Change to Gold or gold tyarn.

R8: turn, BLO (1sc, 1inc)x22 (66)

R10: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60)

R11: (9sc, 1inc)x6 (66)

R12: 66sc

R13: (10sc, linc)x6 (72)

R14: 72sc

R15: (11sc, 1inc)x6 (78)

R16: 78sc

R17: (12sc, 1inc)x6 (84)

R18: 84sc

R19: (13sc, linc)x6 (90)

R20-30: 90sc R31: (1ch, 1ss)x90

(7ch, in the 3rd start 4hdc, 1sc)x10

Secure with 1ch and cut the strand, no length is needed unless you plan to tie the hair to the head with it.

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R6: (4sc, linc)x6 (36)

110. (130, 1110)20 (30

R7: (5sc, 1inc)x6 (42)

R8: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48)

R9: (7sc, 1inc)x6 (54)

R10-12: 54sc

R13: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

R14: 48sc

R15: (6sc, 1dec)x6 (42)

R16: 42sc

R17: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

1ch to secure

Note: Secure with 1ch and cut the strand, leaving enough strand to attach the hair to the head with it. Add superfine golden strand only if you consider it necessary and fill, although just before completely joining the hair it is possible to add more fill.



Note: We recommend sewing the largest piece of hair and the one in the front with only 2 strands of the thread itself, this way the seams will be less noticeable, visit our video in case you cannot understand with the images alone.
