Important note:

This amigurumi is worked with well-adjusted
stitches and for the most part in a spiral
shape, it is not necessary to close each round
unless told to do so, you need to be careful
and always mark the beginning of each
round. It is necessary to read the entire
pattern before beginning.

amigurumi.

Yoshi is approximately 14cm tall

Materiales

- Sinfonia yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Mango Yellow 820, Strong Cinnamon 843, Lemon Green 839, White 801, Garnet Red 823.
- 2.5mm hook for Sinfonia yarn
- Eulali yarn, measures approximately 1mm thick, colors: White C-1
- 1.50mm hook for Eulali yarn
- Superfine thread to embroider the eyes, color: Black and white (you can also use sewing thread)
- Wool Needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- Stuffing for amigurumis
- Pins
- Silicone (glue)
- White felt

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thicker or smaller thread and depending on this thread will be the hook number.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.

Abbreviations:

- R: Round
- ch: chain stitch
- MR: Magic ring
- sc: single crochet
- dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)
- inc: Increase (2sc in 1 stitch)
- dc: double crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- ss: Slip stitch
- FLO: Front Loop Only (take only the front strand)
- BLO: Back Loop Only (take only the back strand)





Legs (x2)

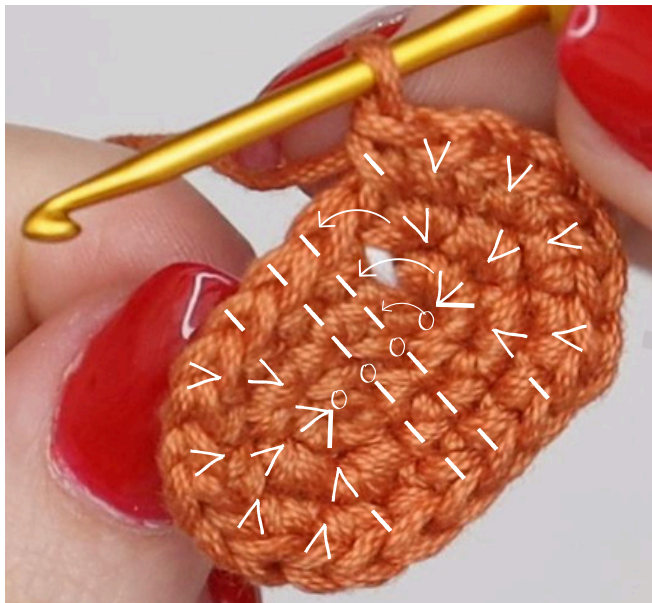
Start with strong tan color yarn

R1: Start with 4ch, (2sc, 1 triple inc)x2 (10)

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

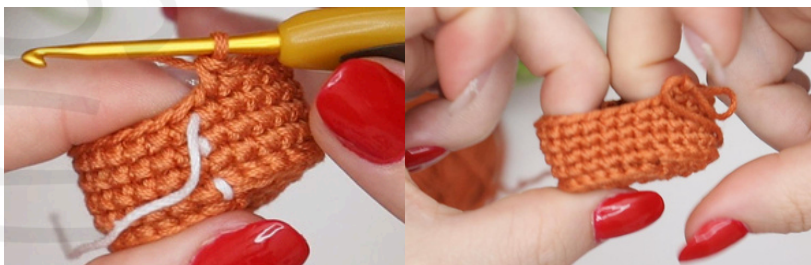
R4: 24sc reverse

Note: When finishing R8 make a chain to temporarily secure. Prepare this piece to place hat silicone, this is optional to have better support, but you can only use filling in your amigurumi (see video for greater understanding)

Tip: Do both legs at the same time, this will ensure that they are as similar as possible, remember that the fabric depends a lot even on our mood.

R9: 2sc, 5dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (18)

R10: 2sc, 3dec, 10sc (15)

R11: 15sc Change to lime green color in the last sc of this R.

Shoe detail

Work on strands that were free of R11

FLO Extract a yarn over, (1ch, 1sc)x15

Close using wool needle (see video)

R14: (4sc, 1inc)x3 (18)

R15: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R16-19: 24sc

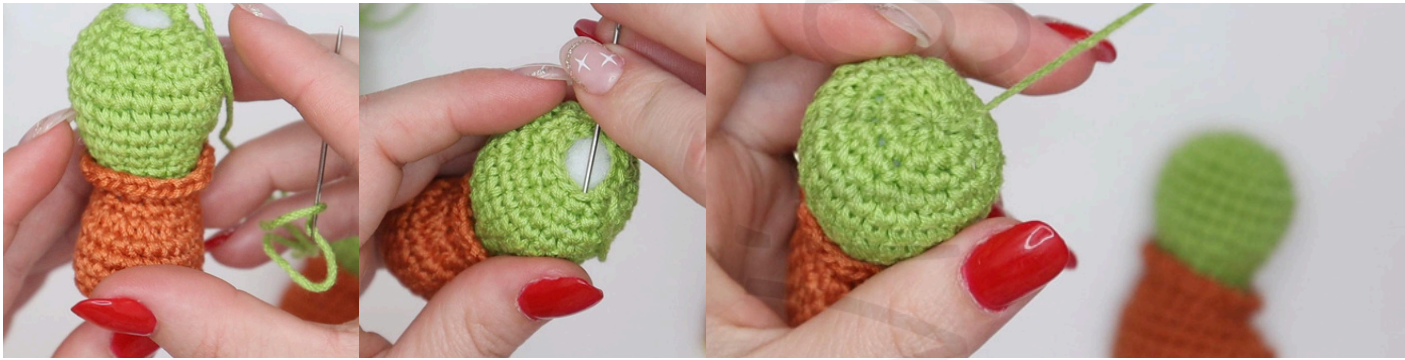
R20: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

R21: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R22: 12sc Close using wool needle (see video for closure)

Shoe plant

Use mango yellow thread

R1: Start with 4ch, (2sc, 1 triple inc)x2 (10)

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

Close with a wool needle and glue.

Body

Use lemon green color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R6: (4sc, 1inc)x5 (36)

R7: (5sc, 1inc)x6 (42)

R8: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48)

R9-13: 48sc

R14: (6sc, 1dec)x6 (42)

R15-17: 42sc

R18: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

R19-20: 36sc

Perform 1ch to temporarily secure while joining this piece with the legs.

Then the R21 will continue

R22-24: 30sc

R25: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24)

R26: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

Eyes (x2)

Utilizar hilo verde limón

Use lemon green color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9)

R3: (2sc, 1inc)x3 (12)

R4: (3sc, 1inc)x3 (15)

When finishing 1 piece, make 1ch to secure and cut the thread that is not needed long, when finishing the 2nd piece do not cut the thread to continue with the union.

Next begins the head

R5: 7sc, 15sc in the other piece, 8sc in the next (30)
close the center
(watch video)



R6-7: 30sc

R8: (1sc, 1inc)x7, 16sc (37)

R9: 37sc

R10: 3sc, (2sc, 1inc)x5, 19sc (42)

R11-18: 42sc (42)

R19: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

R20: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

R21: 30sc

R22: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24)

R23: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

Leave a long strand to join the body and fill.

When making the union you must make sure to place everything in the correct position, the back of the head will be where we make the most increases, where it has the most volume and use the same strand of the head for the union (watch the video for greater understanding).

Tail

Use lemon green color yarn

- R1: MR 6sc
- R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9)
- R3: 9sc
- R4: (2sc, 1inc)x3 (12)
- R5: (3sc, 1inc)x3 (15)
- R6: (4sc, 1inc)x3 (18)
- R7: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)
- R8: 24sc
- R9: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)
- R10: 14sc, (3hdc, 1hdc)x4 (34)
- R11: 14sc, 1hdc, 18dc, 1hdc (34)
- R12 : 14sc

Leave the thread long to join with the body, before closing it using a wool needle.

Note: For the union it is necessary to determine the center of this piece and make it coincide with the center of the magic ring at the bottom of the body. Just before closing completely it is necessary to fill

Snout

Use lemon green thread

- R1: MR 6sc
- R2: 6inc (12)
- R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)
- R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)
- R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)
- R6: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)
- R7-9: 36sc
- R10: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)
- R11: 30sc

Leave the thread long to join with the body, before closing it using a wool needle.

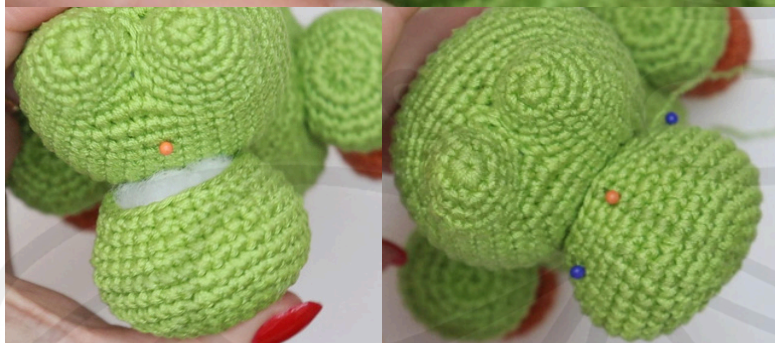
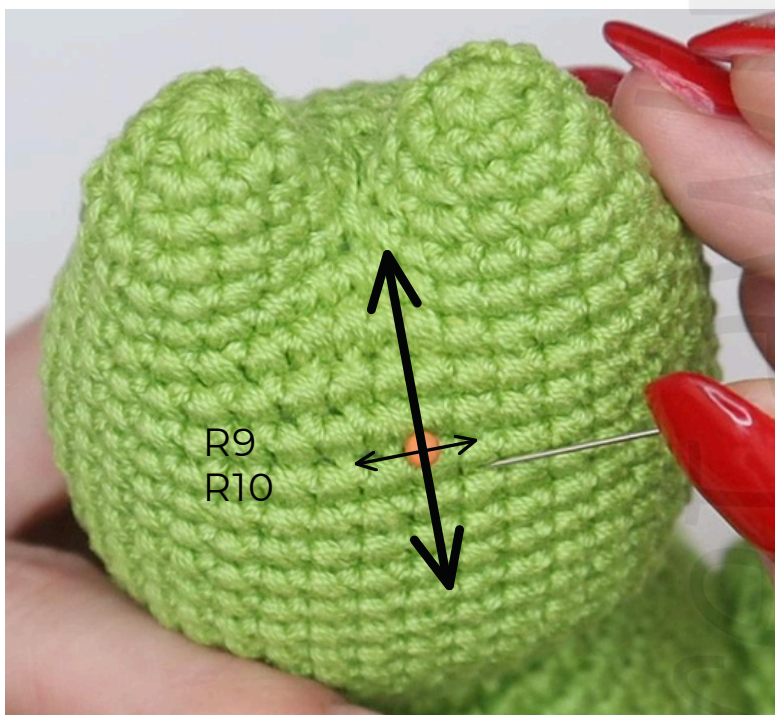

Note: Between R9 and R10 of the head, counting from the beginning, place a marker as centered as possible, it will be the guide to join the snout. Always fill a little more before closing completely.

Shell

Use garnet red color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

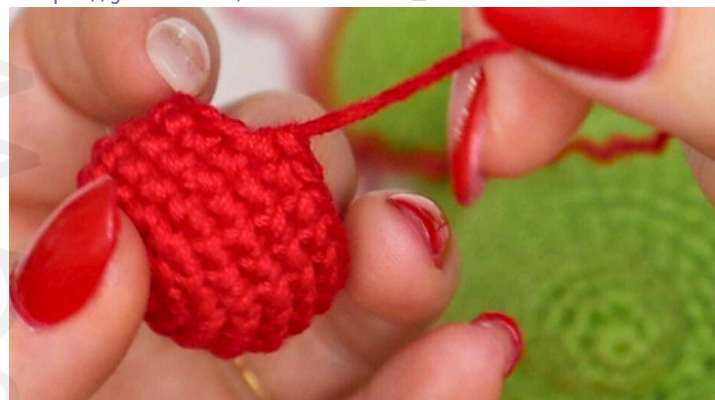
R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (5sc, 1inc)x3 (21)

R5-7: 21sc

Leave the strand long for the union with the body.

Cord

Eulali yarn 1mm thick, hook 1.50mm, white color

R1: MR 6sc

R2-34: 6sc

Cut the strand leaving it long enough for the union.

Crest (x3)

Use garnet red color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9)

R3: (2sc, 1inc)x3 (12)

R4: 12sc

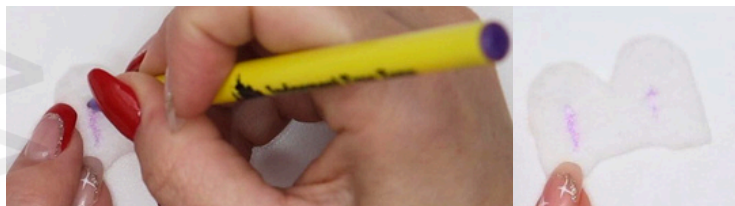
Leave the long thread on each piece to join the head at the back.

Use white felt for the background of the eyes, then with superfine black and white thread embroider the eyes (see video). Glue using silicone glue or whatever you prefer.

Belly

Use white color yarn

R1: 6ch, in the 2nd start 5sc (5)

R2-4: turn, 5sc (5)

R5: turn, 1inc, 3sc, 1inc (7)

R6: turn, 7sc (7)

R7: turn, 1inc, 5sc, 1inc (9)

R8: turn, 9sc (9)

R9: turn, 1inc, 7sc, 1inc (11)

R10: turn, 11sc (11)

R11: turn, 1inc, 9sc, 1inc (13)

R12-33: turn, 13sc (13)

R34: turn, 1dec, 9sc, 1dec (11)

R35-36: turn, 11sc (11)

R37: turn, 1dec, 7sc, 1dec (9)

R38: turn, 9sc (9)

R39: turn, 1dec, 5sc, 1dec (7)

R40: turn, 7sc (7)

R41: turn, 1dec, 3sc, 1dec (5)

R42: turn, 5sc (5)

R43: turn, 1sc, 1dec, 1sc (3)

R44: turn, triple 1dec, 1c to secure.

Attach this piece to the body starting at the bottom of the snout and stretch until you reach the tip of its tail, the fabric gives enough for this.

Cheeks (x2)

Use white color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: 24sc

Close with a wool needle (watch video)

Note: Then join very close to the previous piece and finally sew both together. The cheeks do not need filling but if you want to place the filling you can do so just before completely joining the piece.

Arms (x2)

Use lemon green thread

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x3 (9)

R3: (2sc, 1inc)x3 (12)

R4: 5sc, (bobble point: 4hdc), 6sc (12)

R5: (2sc, 1dec)x3 (9)

R6-14: 9sc

R15: Close with 4sc

Cut the thread leaving it long enough to attach the arm to the body using a wool needle. Place filling only in the front part.

Egg

Use lemon green or white thread.

R1: AM 6pb

R2: 6aum (12)

R3: (1sc, 1aum)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1aum)x6 (24)

R5-7: 24pb

R8: (6sc, 1dis)x3 (21)

R9: 21pb

R10: (5sc, 1dis)x3 (18)

R11: (1sc, 1dis)x6 (12)

R12-13: 12pb

Close with wool needle



Spots (x4)

Use white or lemon green thread

R1: AM 6pb

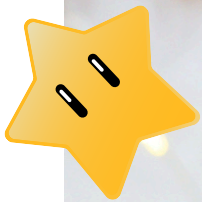
R2: 6aum (12)

Close with wool needle
