Important Note:

This amigurumi is worked with tight V-shaped and spiral stitches. Do not close off each row unless indicated: make sure to always mark the beginning of each row. Please read the entire pattern before starting. We have a tutorial on our channel to make this amigurumi. You can access the links attached to each image if you have any questions. If you find any errors in this pattern, please contact me.





This amigurumi is approximately 19cm tall, and you can articulate its body. This amigurumi stands on its own with a lot of balance but it could easily fall over.

Important Note:

This pattern can be adapted to create amigurumi of different sizes using yarn of different thicknesses. Adjust the hook size according to the thickness of the yarn selected. Also consider the size of the safety eyes if you decide to use them.

I hope you enjoy designing this pattern for yourself as much as I did.

Materials:

- 100% Mercerized Cotton thread (Sinfonia brand), average thickness approximately 3mm. Colors: black, sand, red (garnet), flesh or skin, white and gold with 2.5 mm hook
- Super fine thread (1mm) in black only for the detail on the arms.
- 6mm safety eyes.
- Wool needle
- Scissors
- Time marker
- Pins
- Stuffing for amigurumis
- Glue

• R: Round

• ch: chain

• AM: Magic ring

• pb: single crochet

• dec: decrease (sc 2tog)

• inc: increase (2 sc in 1 stitch)

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

• ss: slip stitch

• FLO: Front Loop Only

• BLO: Back Loop Only





Legs (x2)

Start using black thread

R1: MR 8sc R2: 8inc (16) R3: BLO 16sc

R4: 6sc, 2dec, 6sc (14) R5: 1dec, 3sc, 2dec, 3sc, 1dec (10)

Once the R5 is finished, it is necessary to achieve a flat base. To do this, we will apply silicone glue. Using the hot glue gun, drop the glue into the piece; it will settle on its own. Keep the piece on the table and, when the silicone cools and dries, you will have a flat and hard base. You can also place a small piece of plastic or even a button, but it is essential that you add something so that, when you add the filler, the base does not become bulging.




R6-9: 10sc Change to Sand color thread R10: BLO 10ss

Every time you need to make a color change, follow these steps:

- 1. Finish the last stitch of the round and pull out the yarn over slightly.
- 2. Insert the hook through the center of the stitch, as shown in the picture.
- 3. Draw the new color and start the next round.
- 4. Before finishing this round, pull the strand of the previous color and secure it to the new color with a simple knot.
- 5. Leave the strands inside the piece so that they become part of the filling.

I won't go into this explanation any further. From now on, whenever you make a color change, do it this way with the corresponding colors.

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R11: BLO 10sc

R13: 4sc, 2inc, 4sc (12)

R14-17: 12sc

Next, we will join the legs in R18. When the first leg is finished, cut the thread and make a perfect fastener. Let me explain what a perfect fastener is:

- After cutting the thread, pull it out and attach a tapestry needle.
- Skip a stitch and, in the next stitch, pass the tapestry needle under the chain that forms above the stitch.
- Then insert the tapestry needle just above the last stitch you made.

Whenever a perfect close is mentioned, follow these steps exactly.

It is necessary to determine which will be the center side of each leg where we will join; to do this, use markers. Although I provide you with the exact stitches to be made in this round, the most important thing is that at the beginning of the round you knit as many stitches as you need until you reach your marker, and then finish the round with the remaining stitches of that leg. Place the leg in front of you and, with your fingers, as shown in the picture, determine the center. Please watch the video for better understanding.







R18: 10sc, 1ch, 10sc, 1sc in a ch, 2sc (26) https://youtu.be/iTGgrtmJe2o?t=850

Detail of the suit

Start by flipping the piece over and working in the red strands you left free starting at the back.

Use red thread

R1: 1ch, at the same base start (5sc, 1inc)x4 (28)

R2-6: 28sc

Cut the thread leaving it long enough to make a perfect closure.

Body continuation R30: (5sc, linc)x4 (28)

R31-33: 28sc

R34: (5sc, 1dec)x4 (24) Change to flesh-

colored yarn R35: BLO 24pd R36: BLO 24sc

R37: 24sc

R38: (5sc, linc)x4 (28)

R39-46: 28sc

Place the 6mm safety eyes between rounds 41 and 42, 6 stitches apart. Make sure to place them as centered as possible.



Use your hook to lightly create the hole where you will place the safety eye. It is important to note that when placing such small safety eyes, it is necessary to place the rear safety washer with the narrowest part towards the fabric, to prevent the eye from sinking.





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R47: (2sc, 1dec)x7 (21) R48: (1sc, 1dec)x7 (14)

R49: 14sc

When finished, add enough stuffing and close using a tapestry needle. To better understand this closure, please watch the video.

Bigotes (x2)

Use white yarn

R1: AM 8sc

R2: 8sc

R3: (2sc, 1dec)x2 (6)

R4: 6sc

These pieces do not require stuffing.
Simply close each one using a tapestry needle.

Hair (x8)

Use white thread

Start with 1 slip knot

R1: 5ch, in the 2nd begin (3sc, 1triple inc)x2 (12)


R2-11: 12sc

R12: 5sc closing



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When finished, make a chain to secure, cut the strand and hide it. Then, shape the hair using glue.

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Arms (x2)

Start using flesh-colored yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)


R3: (2sc, 1dec)x2 (6) Change to Red color yarn

R4: BLO 6ss R5: BLO 6sc

Detail on the arm (x2)

Use gold colored yarn

R1: MR 9sc R2: BI O 9sc

R3-4: 9sc

R5: 2sc, 1hdc, 2dc, 1hdc, 3sc

Using a wool needle, make a perfect closure.

Next, arrange the piece, paying special attention to forming the hole to insert the arm. It is very important that the two double crochets you made are facing forward and that the color change between the flesh tone and the red on the arm is facing back. Then, with two strands of the same gold thread, make a stitch from side to side, making sure they do not separate in the future. If you wish, you can also glue it together.


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

Use black yarn

R1: MR 8sc

R2: 8inc (16)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x8 (24) R4: (2sc, 1inc)x8 (32)

R5: 1sc, 1inc, (3sc, 1inc)x7, 2sc (40)

R6: 40sc reversed

R7-9: 40sc

R10: (8sc, 1dec)x4 (36)

R11-12: 36sc

R13: (7sc, 1dec)x4 (32)


R14-16: 32sc

R17: 1ch, BLO (1hdc, 1hdc inc)x16 (48) Make a perfect closure using lanera needle








Embroider the eyebrows using a strand of white thread. Two stitches will be enough.

You can secure at the top - remember you will be putting the hat on later.

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For the detail of the shoes, use a white thread and make two crosses.

Place the arms on either side of the body, making sure the high points of the gold detail are towards the front of your amigurumi. The whiskers can be positioned however you like; notice how the bottom part is slightly above the jacket. I'll just glue them together, but you can sew them for extra security.

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The hair will also be glued on. Start with the two front pieces, placing them so that the bottoms touch the tops of the arms. Make sure to always place the four bottom pieces first, then the other four on top. Finally, add the hat, making sure the gold detail is towards the front. The hat needs a little stuffing to keep its shape, but not too much.
