This design has been created in standard adult sizes. Thanks to the granny square structure, the garment has a versatile drape that comfortably adapts to different sizes.

- R: Round
- AM: Magic ring
- c: Chain
- sl st: Slip stitch
- dc: Double crochet

### Detailed List of Materials

#### Yarns and Fibers:

- Texture Combination (White): Approximately 200 g. In this design, I used a combination of two strands to achieve a thickness of 3 mm: a super-fine chenille strand alongside a fuzzy, frayed strand. (Both were taken from a recycled sweater, which gives it that unique, soft texture.)
- 100% Cotton (Pink): Approximately 100g. This is a 100% cotton, 4-ply yarn. To match the thickness of the previous material, we will be combining two strands (taking one from the center and one from the outside of the ball).
- Note on materials: If you prefer not to combine yarns, you can use a medium-weight acrylic yarn (Size 4); you will get the same size result. See video

#### Tools: see video

- Hook: 4.25 mm (used for both materials to maintain uniform tension).
- Yarn needle: Essential for joining granny squares and hiding excess threads for a clean finish.
- Scissors.
- Stitch markers: Very important to accurately calculate the position of the hood on the scarf and ensure that everything is centered.

#### Granny Square Measurements (for reference):

- Small Granny (scarf and pockets): Approximately 17.5 cm (7 inches).
- Large Granny (hood): Approximately 24 cm.

## Structure and Quantity of Granny Squares

For this project we will make a total of 12 Granny Squares, distributed as follows:

1. For the Scarf and Pockets (10 Small Granny Squares of 6 rounds)
  - 6 White Heart Granny Squares (with pink background).
  - 4 Pink Heart Granny Squares (with white background).
    - Note: We'll use 8 for the length of the scarf and the remaining 2 for the pockets. See video
  
2. For the Hood (2 Large 9-Round Granny Squares) For the hood we will make the two larger squares:
  - 2 Large Pink Heart Granny Squares (with white background).
    - Note: In my design both are the same, but you are free to combine them as you prefer (for example, one of each color).
  - Instructions for enlarging: Follow the original heart pattern up to round 6. Then, you must knit 3 more rounds (Rounds 7, 8 and 9) to give the necessary height:
    - Crochet a double crochet over each double crochet of the previous round.
    - In each of the 4 corners, work the following increase: 2 double crochets, 2 chains, and 2 double crochets into the chain space. See video

Complete summary of parts for this design:

- Total White Heart: 6 small ones.
- Total Pink Hearts: 4 small + 2 large.

**⚠ IMPORTANT NOTE:** > To professionally join all these granny squares, assemble the pockets, and finalize the hood, you need to watch our step-by-step video tutorial. There, I explain in detail how to position each piece so your scarf is perfect and has a flawless finish.

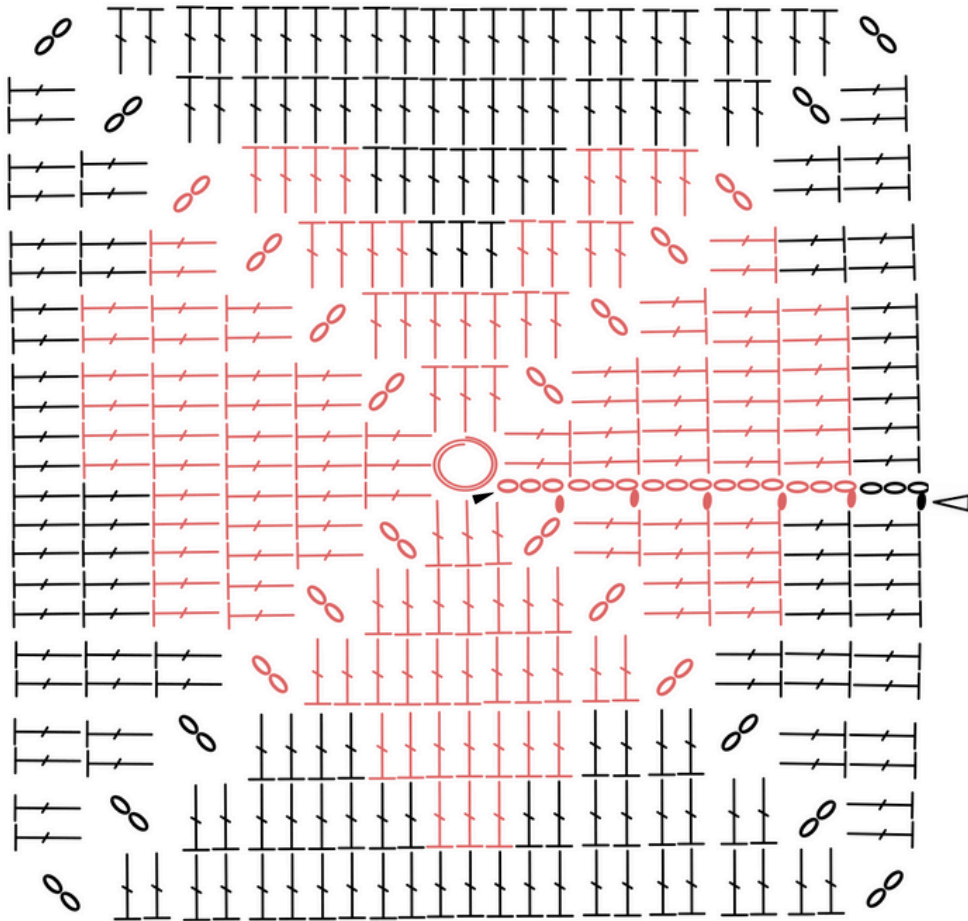
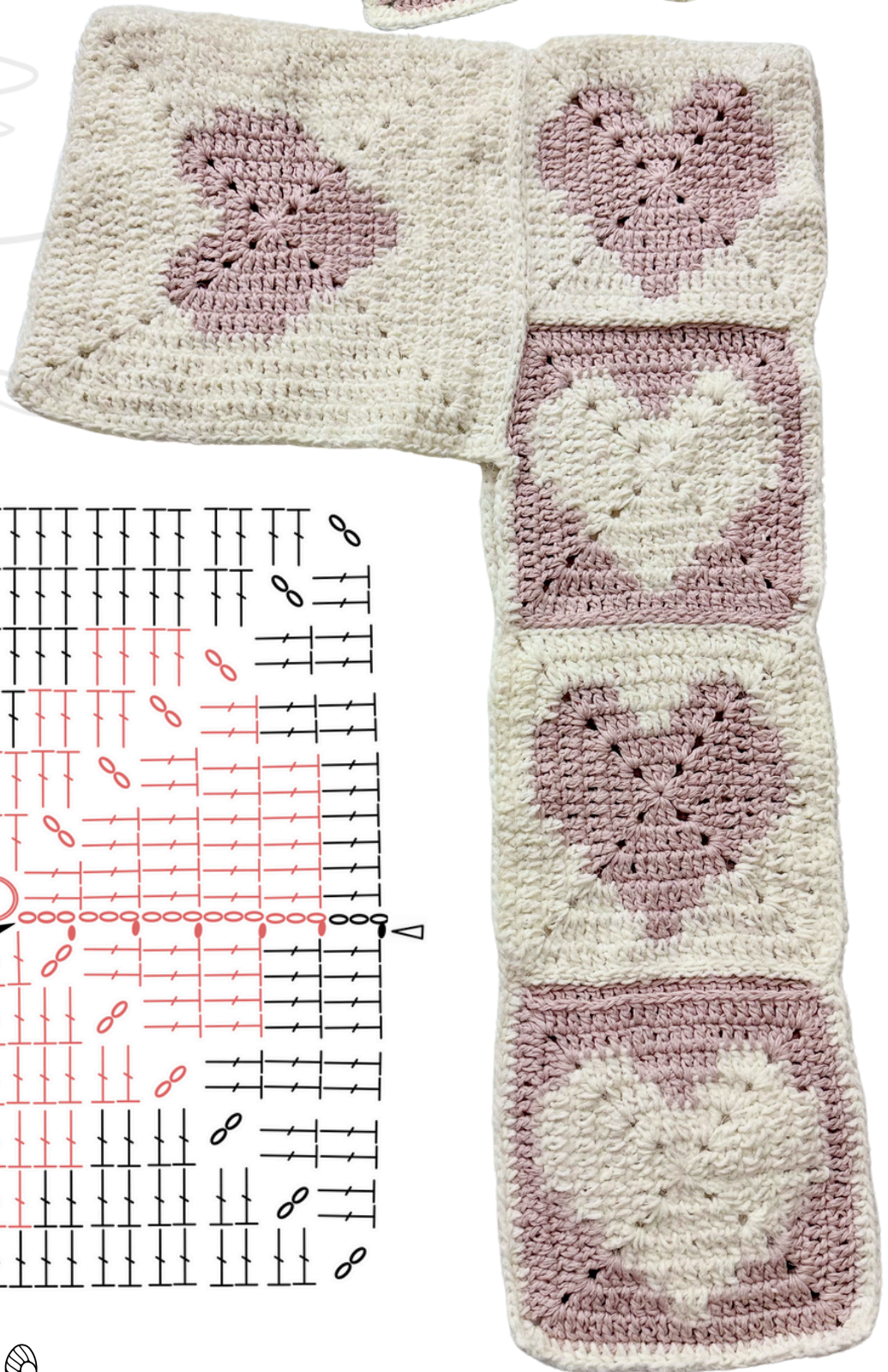
