This amigurumi is worked with tight
stitches and mostly in a spiral pattern, do
not close each round unless prompted, you
will have to be careful and always mark the
start of each lap. Please read the entire
pattern before starting.

This octopus measures approximately 14cm.

Materials:

- Yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton 3mm, Colors: the combination you want
- I used Fresco 40g, sand, sky blue, pink and black
- 2.5mm hook
- wool needle
- temporary marker
- Scissors
- 100% hypoallergenic filling
- pins
- 6mm safety eyes

Abreviaturas:

- R: Round
- ch: chain
- MR: Magic Ring
- sc: single crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- dc: double crochet
- dec: decrease (close 2sc together)
- inc: Increase (2sc in 1st)
- ss: slip stitch

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.





Head

Fresh color yarn (green)

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R6: 2sc, 1inc, (4sc, 1inc)x5, 2sc (36)

R7: (5sc, 1inc)x6 (42)

R8: 3sc, 1inc, (6sc, 1inc)x5, 3sc (48)

R9: (7sc, 1inc)x6 (54)

R10-15: 54sc

R16: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

R17-18: 48sc

R19: (6sc, 1dec)x6 (42)

R20-21: 42sc

R22: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

R23-24: 36sc

R25: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

R26-27: 30sc

Tentacles (Make 10)

R28: FLO 1ss, (24ch, start on 3rd ch, BLO 2hdc, 20dc, skip 2 stitches, 1ss)x10

Leave long strand for union

Note: This time you will take the strand that forms behind each chain, please, if you cannot see this strand in the image that I share, go to the link and it will be easier for you

The last slip stitch will be where you did the 1st slip stitch when starting the tentacles

Leave a long thread for the union then with the base of the tentacles

Place 6mm safety eyes between Rounds 4 and 5 with 8 stitches apart

For this detail in the eyes, use a strand of sky blue thread, you can give 1 or two stitches, it will be enough

Base for tentacles

Use Sand color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

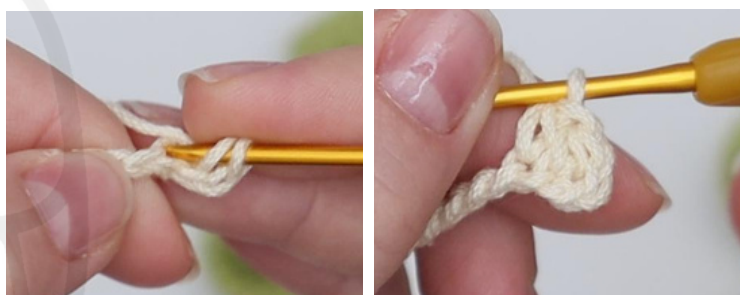
R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R5: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R6: BLO 1ss, [24ch, in 3rd start, 2hdc, (4dc closed together at the same Base (mote point), 4dc)x4, skip 2 stitches, 1ss]x10

For the union of the tentacles I suggest you go to the link that I share, a suggestion to make this union easier is to use the back part where the strand is placed in the wool needle and take the back strands, both pieces have exactly the same number of points

Use pink color yarn

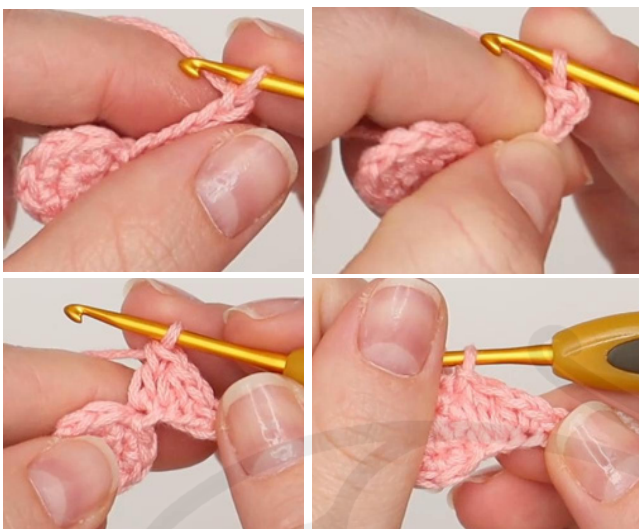
R1: MR 5sc

R2: 5inc (10)

R3: 1ss, (5ch, starting in the 2nd BLO 1ss, 1sc, 1 hdc, skip 1st, in the next 1ss)x5



Using a wool needle and only one strand of the same thread, make the joint where you want to place it.
