# This Princess measures approximately 29cm

## Materials that I have used:

- -100% Mercerized Cotton Yarn 3mm, Colors: Skin color 66g, cinnamon, white, sky blue, Yellow 20g for hair and navy blue
- 2.5mm hook
- Wool needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- 100% hypoallergenic
- padding Silicone tube, 1cm diameter and never less than 12cm long
- Pins
- 10mm safety eyes
- Blush for her cheeks
- Closure for the dress (Velcro)

Abbreviations:

R: round ch: chain MR: Magic ring sc: single crochet hdc: half double crochet dc: double crochet dec : decrease (2sc together) hdc dec: decrease (close 2hdc together) hdc dc: decrease (close 2dc together) inc : Increase (2sc in 1st) triple inc: Increase (3sc in 1st) inc dc: Increase (2dc in 1st) inc sc: Increase (2dc in 1st) ss: Slip stitch FLO: Front Loops Only (take only the front thread) BLO: Back Loops Only (take only the back thread)

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi bigger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes and the support for her neck

Enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it





Let's start with the Body Arms (Make 2) Flesh Color yarn R1: MR 6sc R2: 6inc (12) R3-7: 12sc (60sc in total) R8: (4sc, 1dEC)x2 (10) R9-24: 10sc (160sc in total)



Cut yarn at the end of each Arm and Stuff

Legs (Make 2)

Start with Flesh color yarn R1: 4ch, on 2nd start (2sc, 1triple inc)x2 (10)

Note: I suggest you mark Chain number 4 before you start making the first single crochet, because once we work the 2nd repetition on the other side of the chains, right in that 4th chain is where we will do the last triple increase



https://youtu.be/Xu4cjvstYqs?t=154 R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16) R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24) R4-6: 24sc R7: 6dec, 12sc (18) R8: 18sc R9: 3dec, 6sc, 1dec, 4sc (14) R10-30: 14sc (294sc in total)

In the first leg that he made, he will cut the yarn and in the second leg he will change to Sky Blue in the last low point of the V30 to make the inner clothes

You will join the two legs forming a single piece

R31: 9sc on the same leg where you made the color change, 2ch, starting at the 3rd point of the other leg in such a way that both are with the toes facing forward, 14sc, 2sc on the 2ch, 5sc on the leg who started this round (this round will end with 32 points)

R32-36: 32sc R37: (6sc, 1dis)x4 (28) Change to color Meat in the last decrease of this V V38: 28sc V39: (5sc, 1dis)x4 (24) V40-48: 24sc V49: 4sc, 10sc in one arm, 12sc, 10sc in the other arm, 8sc (44) Note: In turn, you can secure the thread that was left on your arm.

R50: (2sc, 1dec)x11 (33) R51-52: 33sc R53: (1sc, 1dec)x11 (22) R54: 22sc

Note: Must fill in as the tissue progresses and create a hole to then insert the silicone tube or the material you want to use to support her head. R55: 11dec (11) R56-57: 11sc R58: 10sc, 1inc (12)





#### Head

R59: 12inc (24) R60: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30) R61: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36) R62: 2sc, 1inc, (5sc, 1inc)x5, 3sc (42) R63: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48) R64: 3sc, 1inc, (7sc, 1inc)x5, 4sc (54) R65: 54sc R66: (8sc, 1inc)x6 (60) R67: 4sc, 1inc, (9sc, 1inc)x5, 5sc (66) R68: (10sc, 1inc)x6 (72) R69-77: 72sc Place the eyes between the R73 and R74 with approximately 13 points of

separation.

Place the silicone tube or the material you want to use to support her head, it may be easier if you make a tip to the silicone, please see the link for more details . You can also place it whenever you want and you consider how to knit more at ease

R78: (10sc, 1dec)x6 (66) R79-81: 66sc R82: (9sc, 1dec)x6 (60) R83: 3sc, 1dec,(8sc, 1dec)x5, 5sc (54) R84: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48) R85: 3sc, 1dec,(6sc, 1dec)x5, 3sc (42) R86: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36) Note: After the R86 fill as much as possible so that the filling will firm up the material you placed in the center, if you are using a silicone tube cut it right where the head ends, continue closing with the following rounds and at the same time filling if necessary.







R87: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30) R88: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24) R89: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18) R90: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12) R91: 6dec (6) Close with wool needle

## Ears

R1: MR 5sc R2: turn, 2sc, 1inc, 2sc (6) Leave the long thread to sew to the head.

Place the ears 8sc apart from each safety eye






Face Embroidery Use white, brown and flesh thread for the nose, enter the link if you need it. https://youtu.be/pVljvZrqC9w?t=2975

Use yellow color yarn R1: MR 6sc R2: 6inc (12) R3: (1sc, 1inc )x6 (18) R4: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24) R5: 1sc, 1inc, (3sc, 1inc)x5, 2sc (30) R6: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36) R7-10: 36sc R11 : (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30) R12-13: 30sc R14: FLO (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R15: 2sc, linc, (5sc, linc)x5, 3sc (42) R16: (6sc, linc)x6 (48) R17: 3sc, linc, (7sc, linc)x5, 4sc (54) R18: (8sc, linc)x6 (60) R19: 60sc R20 : 4sc, linc, (9sc, linc)x5, 5sc (66) R21: 66sc R22: (10sc, linc)x6 (72) R23-28: 72sc R29-31: 36sc, 36hdc (72)





# Tufts

Yellow color yarn yarn Start at point 11 from the inside out [12ch, in the 3rd start, 10 hdc, 1ss in the next stitch ]x16

#### Headband

Sky Blue color yarn 41ch, in the 2nd start (5ss, 5sc, 20hdc, 5sc, 5ss, 1ch, 6hdc in the same base, 1ch)x2, 1ss Cut leaving a long yarn and then sew to the head, with a wool needle. stitches taking the back threads of each stitch.

Sky Blue color yarn R1: 37ch, in 2nd start (5sc, 1inc)x6 (42) R2: turn , 42sc R3: turn, [6sc, (inc: 1 hdc, 1dc), 2ch, skip 10 stitches, (inc: 1dc, 1hdc)]x2, 6sc (30) https://youtu.be/AJ8UkcEyyzQ?t=147



R4-9: turn, 30sc R10: 1ch, turn, BLO 30hdc inc (60) R11: (3dc,1inc hdc)x15, 1dc (75)



R12-20: 1ch,75hdc, 1ss (75) Close with wool needle





## Inner skirt

Use White color yarn R1: 1ch, 30hdc inc (60) Taking the thread left when we made R10 of the dress

R2: 1ch, turn, 60hc, 1dc in the 1st hdc of this Round (60) R3-10: 1ch, 60hdc, 1ss (60) R11: (1ch, 1hdc in the same stitch, 1ss in the next stitch)x60 Close with wool needle



# Sleeves

We will start each sleeve at the Base of the increase in hdc and dc of the R3 of the Dress.

#### White color yarn

R1: draw loop, at the next point, linc, 1hdc inc, 6dc inc, 1hdc inc, 1inc, 1ss

R2: turn, 1dec, 1hdc dec, 6dc dec, 1hdc dec, 1dec, 1ss R3: turn, 18ss approx, it's just a finish.







For more detail, make slip stitches around the edge of the shoulders

## Dress Closure

Using a piece of velcro, close the dress using silicone glue

Use royal blue color yarn thread With just one strand, knot around her neck and then hide the remaining thread using a wool needle

#### Shoes (make2)

Sky Blue color yarn R1: 4ch, in the 2nd start (2sc, 1 triple inc)x2 (10) Note: This R1 is the same as the R1 of the legs. R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16) R3: (2sc, 6inc)x2 (28) R4: BLO 28sc R5-8: 28sc R9: 2 c. 6dec, 14sc (22) R10: turn, 12 sc (12) Note: Up to R10 both shoes will be exactly the same, when the first one finishes up to R10 it will continue with the R11 that

corresponds to the left shoe and then when the second one will continue with the R11 corresponding to the right

#### shoe Left shoe

R11: 25ch, turn, 12sc starting in the last sc of the previous R, 13ss.

#### Right shoe

R11: turn, 12sc, 25ch, 1sc at the base of the last sc that we made, 12ss.

White Make MR, (3ch to go up, 2dc, 3ch, 1ss inside the ring)x2. Close and join the shoe
