The head of this amigurumi rotates and it
is important to know this so that you
understand the pattern, amigurumi is
worked with well-adjusted stitches and for
the most part in a spiral shape, do not close
each round unless I tell you to, you will
have to be careful and always mark the
beginning of each round. Please read the
entire pattern before beginning.

In the description, before buying this
pattern, I told you that we have a tutorial
on our channel to make this amigurumi.

This amigurumi measures approximately 27cm

Materials:

- Sinfonia yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Strong Cinnamon 843, Sand 861, Fresh 866 (green), Lilac 828, Tangerine 821, Oxford 887 (almost black), Pumpkin 870 (orange) and Gold 869.
- Hook 2.5mm
- Lanera Needle
- Temporary marker
- Scissors
- Stuffing for amigurumis
- Pins
- Flat piece of wood or other material for the sole of the shoe
- A button for the dress
- 10mm safety eyes

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thicker or smaller thread and depending on this thread will be the hook number. In the same way, you will choose, you must take into account the size of your eyes.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I do.
by designing it for you.

Abbreviations:

- A: Round
- ch: chain
- MR: Magic Ring
- sc: single crochet
- dec: decrease (close 2sc together)
- inc: Increase (2 sc in 1 stitch)
- dc: double crochet
- hdc: half double crochet
- ss: slip stitch
- FLO: Front Loop Only (take only the front loop)
- BLO: Back Loop Only (take only the back loop)



Arms (x2)

Start using fresh colored thread (green)

R1: MR 6sc

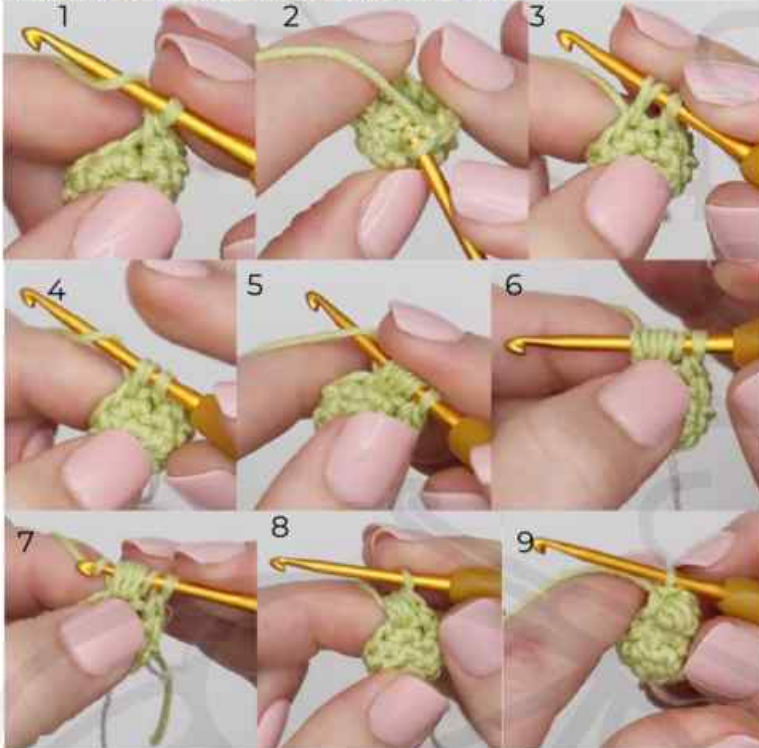
R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3: (3sc, 1inc)x2 (10)

R4: 4sc, 1dot speck (3 hdc closed together in the same place), 5sc (10)

R5: (3sc, 1dec)x2 (8)

R6-7: 8sc Change to Lilac

Note: Change color at the last low point of the R7



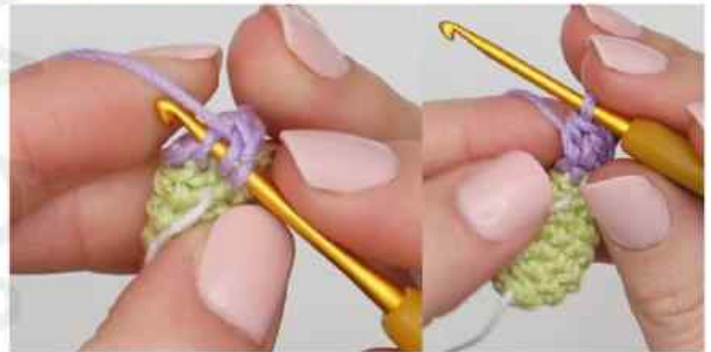
R8: BLO 8ss

R9: 1ch, FLO 8hdc inc

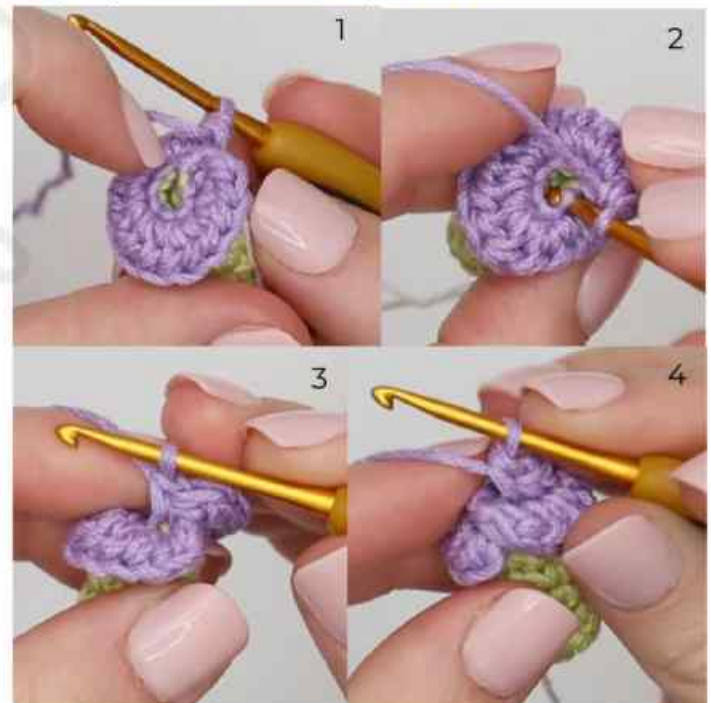

Note: The next round is done without cutting the strand, continue starting on the first back strand of those left.

R10: BLO 8sc

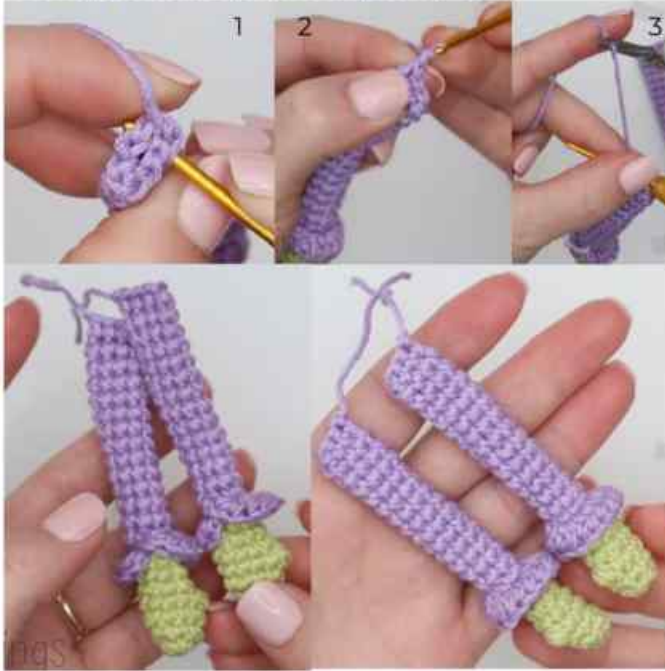

R11-23: 8sc

R24: 3sc to close by taking a stitch on each side, 1c to secure and cut the yarn, no length needed.

R7: 3sc, 6dec, 4sc, 2dec, 1sc (16)

R8: FLO 1ss, (1ch, FLO 1sc in the next stitch)x16

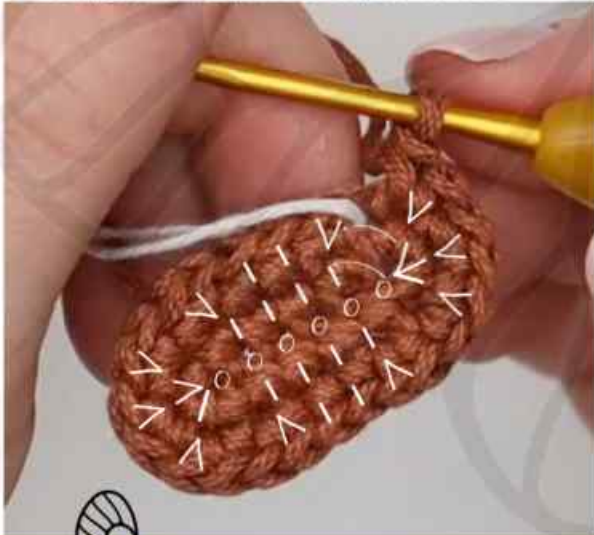
Legs (x2)

Strong tan color yarn

R1: 6ch, in 2nd start (4sc, 1triple inc)x2 (14)

R2: 1inc, 2sc, 5inc, 2sc, 4inc (24)

Note: Close with a wool needle and cut the thread to continue with a new color of thread. Before continuing the next rounds, place a small piece of flat wood or plastic and even hot silicone, just to make the shoe look very flat.

R9: BLO 16ss (16)

Note: Start in the yarn that is free from the last stitch of R7.

R10: BLO 16sc

R11 -12: 16sc Change to fresh color yarn

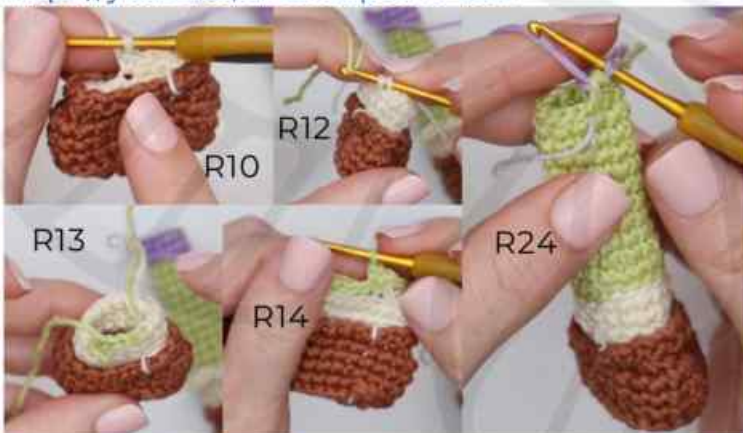
R13: BLO 16ss

R14: BLO 16sc

R15: (2sc, 1dec)x4 (12)

R16-24: 12sc Change to Lilac color yarn

R25: BLO 12ss

R26: BLO 12sc

Note: when finishing the 1st leg after R12, make 1ch and cut the yarn, however when finishing the 2nd leg, do not chain or cut the yarn since the two will then be joined.

For the steering wheel of the stockings will use sand color yarn FLO (1ch, 1sc in the same base, 1ss)x16

The edge to the shoe will be made with 23ss using strong cinnamon color yarn.

R29: (4sc, 1inc)x6 (36)

R30-32: 36sc

R33: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

R34-35: 30sc

R36 : (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24)

R37-38: 24sc

R39: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

R40-41: 18sc



Continuation of the body

R28: 5sc, 3ch, 12sc in the other leg, 3sc in the 3ch, 7sc in the leg we started (30)

Note: If when making the indicated number of stitches your amigurumi's legs do not turn out to be straight, then watch the video we share so you can learn how to modify this round.



Joining arms

R42: 4sc joining one arm, 4sc, 4sc joining another arm, 6sc (18)

Note: The arms need to be at her sides with their fingers facing forward.

R43: 18sc

R44: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R45-54: 12sc

Fill and close with wool needle

Note: Never straighten the fabric, observe the position of the hook, if necessary watch the video.

R13: (7sc, 1inc)x2 (18)

R14: (1sc, 1inc)x9 (27)

R15: (2sc, 1inc)x9 (36)

R16: (3sc, 1inc)x9 (45)



R17-24 : 54sc

R25: (3sc, 1dec)x9 (36)

R26-29: 36sc

Place 10mm safety eyes between R8 and 9 (counting from R29 down) with 10 points of separation

Head

Use fresh colored thread (green)

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (2sc, 1inc)x4 (16)

R4- 12: 16sc



Note: Before continuing it is necessary to attach the head to the body (See video)

Hair

Use tangerine (Orange) thread

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4: (30ch, in 3rd start, BLO 28hdc, 1ss)x18

Note: Before attaching the hair, let's make other sizes

With a strand of white thread and a wool needle, make two stitches under each eye.

With a strand of fresh colored thread (green) and a wool needle, make approximately 6 stitches on top of 3 stitches to form the nose.

Join the center of the hair circle with the center of the head closure. To place each hair it is necessary to watch the video.

Sew in the head using wool needle.

Dress

Start with oxford thread (almost black)

R1: 20ch, in the 6th begin 15dc inc (30)

R2: 1ch, turn, 4dc inc, skip 7st, 8dc inc, skip 7st, 4dc inc (32)

R3: 1ch, turn, (3dc, 1dc inc)x8 (40)

R4: 1ch, turn 40dc (40)

R5: 1ch, turn, 40dc, 1dc (40)

Ears (x2)

MR 1sc, 1hdc, 1dc, 4ch, 1ss

Cut the strand leaving it long to attach it to the head above the hair

R6: 1ch, FLO (1dc, 1dc inc)x20, 1dc (60)

R7: (1ch, in next stitch 1ss)x60

Cut the thread and hide it

Note: Work the next round in the strands that were free from R5.

Use pumpkin colored yarn

R8: 1ch, 40dc, 1ss (40)

R9: 1ch, FLO (1dc, 1dc inc)x20, 1ss (60)

R10: (1ch, in next stitch 1ss)x60

Cut the thread and hide it

Repeat R8, 9 and 10 once more with oxford-colored thread.

Heart

Use gold thread

MR 3ch, 2dc, 1hdc, 1sc, 1ch, 1sc, 1hdc, 2dc, 3ch, 1ss

Close, secure and hide the thread.

R2-4: 6sc

R5: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R6-8: 8sc

R9: (1sc, 1inc)x4 (12)

R10: 12sc

R11: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R12-13: 18sc

R14: (2sc, 1inc)x6 (24)

R15: (3sc, 1inc)x6 (30)

R16: 2sc, 1inc, (4sc, 1inc)x5, 2sc (36)

R17: (5sc, 1inc)x6 (42)

R18: 42sc

R19: (6sc, 1inc)x6 (48) Change to Lilac color yarn
