Important Note:

This amigurumi is worked with tight stitches and mostly in a spiral pattern, do not close each round unless prompted, you will have to be careful and always mark the start of each lap. Please read the entire pattern before starting.

In the description before buying this pattern, I told you that we have a tutorial on our channel to make this amigurumi.

Santa and his Mrs. Claus measure approximately 30cm

Materiales:

- 100% Mercerized Cotton yarn, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Colors: Bordeaux red, flesh, white, strong cinnamon, cinnamon, gold and green
- 1mm thick black thread
- White Chenille fine thread
- 2.5mm hook
- Yarn Needle
- temporary bookmark
- Scissors
- 100% hypoallergenic filling
- pins
- Silicone
- wire for glasses
- Blush

Abreviaturas:

R: Round

ch: chain

MR: Magic Ring

sc: single crochet

dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)

inc: Increase (2 sc in 1 stitch)

triple inc: Increase (3 sc in 1 stitch)

dc: double crochet

hdc: half double crochet

ss: slip stitch

FLO: Front Loop Only

BLO: Back Loops Only

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number, in the same way you will choose the desired size of the safety eyes

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.





Shoes and Legs (Make 4)

Start with strong tan yarn

R1: 4ch, on 2nd start (2sc, 1 triple inc)x2 (10)

Note: I suggest you place a marker on chain number 4 because it

is right there that you will make the last triple increase.

R2: (2sc, 3inc)x2 (16)

R3: 3sc, 4inc, 4sc, 4inc, 1sc (24)

R4: 6sc, 2inc, 10sc, 2inc, 4sc (28)



R5: BLO 28sc

Note: Before continuing fill the plant

with silicone glue

R6-9: 28sc

R10: 2sc, 7dec, 12sc (21)

R11: (1sc, 1dec)x3, 12sc (18)

R12: 4sc, linc, 7sc, ldec, 4sc (18)

R13: FLO 18sc


R14: (1ch, 1ss)x18

Note: The back strands will remain free

to continue with the leg

Start the leg with Bordeaux Red thread

R15: BLO 18sc (Starting at the penultimate stitch, see video link

please)

R16-19: 18sc

R20: (2sc, linc)x6 (24)

R21: 24sc

R22: (2sc, linc)x8 (32)

For the 2nd leg repeat from R1-22, from the 1st leg cut yarn, from the 2nd not to continue with the join.



Union

Note: If the legs are not centered doing the same stitches in the next round, please see the video that I share to locate the side of the legs

R23: 2sc, 32sc in the other leg, 30sc in the leg that we started this join (64)







Continue with the Body

R24: (3sc, linc)x16 (80)

R25-32: 80sc

Note: Make a seam in the center of the joint of the legs, using a yarn needle and a strand of the same burgundy red thread, see video for more details

R33: BLO 80sc

Note: If you wish, you can knit the detail of the Santa's jacket and Mrs. Claus's skirt before stuffing, in the front strands that we have already left free, since it is more difficult with the stuffing in the body.



R35-36: 70sc

R37: 2sc, 1dec, (5sc, 1dec)x9, 3sc (60)

R38-39: 60sc

R40: (8sc, 1dec)x6 (54)

R41: 54sc

R42: 3sc, 1dec, (7sc, 1dec)x5, 4sc

(48)

R43: 48sc

R44: (6sc, 1dec)x6 (42)

R45: 42sc

R46: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

R47: 2sc, 1dec, (4sc, 1dec)x5, 2sc (30)

R48: 30sc

R49: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24)

R50-51: 24sc Change to flesh or

leather color

R52: BLO 24ss

R53: FLO (1sc, 1inc)x12 (36)



R54: 36sc

R56-57: 48sc

R58: (3sc, 1inc)x12 (60)

R59: 2sc, linc, (4sc, linc)x11, 2sc (72)

R60-68: 72sc

Note: I have preferred to embroider the eyes, but if you want to place security eyes, my suggestion is that you use 10mm eyes, place them between R66 and 67 with approximately 13 stitches apart, it is only as a suggestion

R69: (7sc, 1dec)x8 (64)

R70: 3sc, 1dec, (6sc, 1dec)x7, 3sc (56)

R71: 56sc

R72: (12sc, 1dec)x4 (52)

R73: 5sc, 1dec, (11sc, 1dec)x3, 6sc (48)

R74: 48sc

R75: (10sc, 1dec)x4 (44)

R76: 4sc, 1dec, (9sc, 1dec)x3, 5sc (40)

R77: (8sc, 1dec)x4 (36) R78: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

R79: 1sc, 1dec, (3sc, 1dec)x5, 2sc (24)

R80: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18) R81: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R82: 12sc

Hands and Sleeves (Make 4)

Start with nude for the arms of Mrs.

Claus and strong cinnamon for Santa.

R1: MR 8sc

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x4 (12)

R3: (5sc, 1inc)x2 (14)

R4: (6sc, 1inc)x2 (16)

R5: 7sc, (1st speck: 5hdc together),

8sc (16)


R6-7: 16sc

R8: (6sc, 1dec)x2 (14)

R9-14: 14sc

1ch to secure





Use Bordeaux Red thread

R1: 20ch, 1ss in the 1st, 20sc (20)





R2: 20sc

R3: (3sc, 1dec)x4 (16)

R4: (6sc, 1dec)x2 (14)

R5: 14sc

R6: 14sc also taking the points of the

hands (go to the link please)

R9: (5sc, 1dec)x2 (12)

Note: Before closing, place filler only in hand, just a little bit to shape

4 sc to close and 1 c to secure, leave a long strand for later joining

With chenille thread make the edge of the sleeve

Insert at the base of the stitch you prefer, 1c and then 1 sc for each stitch we have





Ears (Make 4)

R1: MR 5sc

R2: turn, 2sc, linc, 2sc (6)

Leave long strands to attach to

the head

Nose (Make 2)

Use flesh or skin colored thread

R1: MR 8sc

R2-3: 8sc

Wool needle closure

Leave a long strand to join to the

head

Santa's jacket

Start with Bordeaux Red thread

Note: Make sure what your center will be to the front and then on each side of the stitch place a pin, one will start on one and the other will end.

Position your body head down with the boot side facing you









Use white chenille yarn for the border

R1: FLO 1ch, (3hdc, 1hdc inc)x19, 3hdc (98)



R2: 1ch, turn, 1hdc dec, 94hdc, 1hdc dec (96)

R3: 1ch, turn, 1hdc dec, 92hdc, 1hdc dec (94)

R4: 1ch, turn, 1hdc dec, 90hdc,



Note: At the end make 1c to secure, you do not need a long strand, we will hide it with the next round R5: Start with the necessary chains from the neck to where the skirt of the jacket begins, Approx 4sc to start, then (1ch, skip 1st 1sc)x all the way around the edge, approx 4sc, make the same chains you started with detail.

Start with Bordeaux Red thread Note: This skirt will begin at the back, you can start where you prefer, working in the front strands that we have left

R1: FLO 1ch, (3hdc, 1hdc inc)x20, 1ss (100)

R2-7: 1ch, 100hdc, 1ss (100)

Note: You do not need to leave a long strand

Use white chenille yarn for the border R8: (1ch, skip 1pt, 1sc)

Union of arms

Use the same strand that is left of each sleeve

Note: Mrs. Claus will then place the cupcake in her arms for that reason they will be positioned slightly differently, see the video for more details

Santa's are placed 5 rounds apart from the neck down and Mrs. Claus has them about 6 rounds apart. Keep your fingers up.
