## Important note:

This amigurumi is worked with welladjusted stitches and for the most part in a
spiral shape, do not close each round
unless I tell you to, you will have to be
careful and always mark the beginning of
each round. Please read the entire pattern
before beginning.

# This amigurumi measures approximately 17cm tall.

#### Materials:

- Sinfonia Yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 3mm thick and has 6 strands. Color: Cinnamon 842 (approximately 35g)
- Eulali Yarn 100% Mercerized Cotton, measures approximately 1mm thick and has 4 strands. Red color
- 2.5mm hook for both yarns
- pink and black sewing thread
- Wool Needle
- Fine sewing needle
- Scissors
- Temporary marker
- Pins
- Glue
- Stuffing for amigurumis
- · Cream and black felt
- 1 pipe cleaner or wire

#### Abbreviations:

R: Round c: chain

AM: Magic Ring

sc: single crochet

dec: decrease (close 2 sc together)

inc: increase (2 sc in 1 stitch)

triple inc: increase (3sc in 1st)

hdc: half double crochet

FLO: Front Loop Only

**BLO: Back Loops Only** 

Note: You can use this same pattern to make this amigurumi larger or smaller using a thread of greater or lesser thickness and depending on this thread will be the hook number.

I hope you enjoy this pattern as much as I did designing it for you.







## Legs (x2) Use tan thread

R1: MR 7sc

R2: 3sc, 1 triple inc, 3sc (9) R3: 4sc, 1 triple inc, 4sc (11) R4: 5sc, 1 triple inc, 5sc (13)


R5: 6sc, 1inc, 6sc (14)

R6: 14sc

R7: (6sc, linc)x2 (16) R8: (3sc, linc)x4 (20) R9: (4sc, linc)x4 (24)

When finishing the 1st leg, make a chain to secure and cut the thread, however when finishing the 2nd leg, do not cut the thread and continue with the union.

R10: 24sc in the other leg, 24sc more (48)

R11: (7sc, 1inc)x6 (54)

Note: Close the hole if you wish using a wool needle and a final strand of the same yarn (see video)

R12-15: 54sc

R16: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

R17-19: 48sc

R20: (6sc, 1dec)x6 (42)

R21-24: 42sc

R25: (5sc, 1dec)x6 (36)

R26-30: 36sc

R31: (4sc, 1dec)x6 (30)

R32-43: 30sc

Note: It is important to place pipe cleaners if you want to articulate your amigurumis and fill them as your knitting progresses.

R44: (3sc, 1dec)x6 (24)

R45: 24sc

R46: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

R47: 18sc

R48: (1sc, 1dec)x6 (12)

R49: 12sc

## Arms (x2)

Use tan color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: (2sc, 1inc)x2 (8)

R3-13 8sc

Ic to secure and leave the long strand to

join to the body

Insert the pipe cleaner or wire inside each arm and sew to the body

Ears (x2)

Use tan thread
MR 2ch, 2hdc, 2dc, 2hdc, 1ch, 1ss
Cut the strand leaving it long to join the body

Tail

Use tan color yarn

R1: MR 6sc R2-3: 6sc

Leave the strand long and then join the body https://youtu.be/JUkRPC3cm4I?t=101







#### Scarf

Use finer yarn (Eulali) red Start with 1 slip knot

R1: 6ch, in the 2nd start 5hdc (5) R2-22: 1ch, turn BLO 5hdc (5)

Closure with 5ss

Note: with both strands, the beginning and the end, secure and then hide them. (watch video)





# Union of all the pieces

By carefully observing each image you will be able to join all the pieces, however for greater understanding you can enter the link

Note: Sew the belly and snout together.

Note: Sew the ears as desired and the tail on top of R16, 18 and 18 as centered as possible (see video)

With glue, join the black circle as well as the pieces for the ears.



#### With needle I have pale pink sewing thread edge the claws
