



Legs (x2)

Start with white color yarn

R1: MR 6sc

R2: 6inc (12)

R3: (1sc, 1inc)x6 (18)

R4-10: 18sc

R11: 1sc, 2hdc, 2dc, 1dc inc, 2dc, 2hdc, 2sc, 1ss

R12: 1ch, turn, skip 1point, 1sc, 2hdc, 5dc, 2hdc, 1sc, 1ss

R13: 1ch, turn, skip 1point, 1sc, 1hdc, 3hdc dec, 1hdc, 1sc

R14: 14sc

R15: (5sc, 1dec)x2 (12)

R16-19: 12sc

R20: (4sc, 1dec)x2 (10)

R21-37: 10sc Change to pink color yarn

R38-39: 10sc

Note: When finishing the 1st leg, cut the yarn, it does not need to be long and make 1c to secure.

When finishing the 2nd leg, do not cut the yarn to continue with the union.

You will mark the center of each leg for this join, in case the points do not match so that your legs look straight (see video)

Union

R40: 3pb, 3ch, 10sc in the other leg, 3sc in the 3ch, 7sc in the next leg (26)

R41-47: 26sc

R48: BLO 26sc

R49: (11sc, 1dec)x2 (24)

R50: 24sc

R51: (2sc, 1dec)x6 (18)

R52: 18sc

R53: (4sc, 1dec)x3 (15)

R54: (3sc, 1dec)x3 (12) Change to White color yarn

Note: Before the color change it is easier to make the skirt now

Skirt

Note: Always start at the back as centered as possible, working on the front strands that we have left free.

Use pink color yarn

Above the front strand that we left when doing R47

R1: 1ch, in the same place begin 26sc inc (52)

R2: (1sc, 1inc)x26 (78)

R3-19: 78sc

R20: 1ss, (1ch, 1ss)x78

Close with wool needle.



Continuation of the head

Continue the following rounds with white thread

R55: 12sc

R56: 12inc (24)

R57: (1sc, 1inc)x12 (36)

R58: (2sc, 1inc)x12 (48)

R59: (7sc, 1inc)x6 (54)

R60-68: 54sc

Note: Filling the neck very well is important for the stability of the material that we later place to support the head.

We will be using silicone tube approximately 8 inches long, it is necessary to prepare the tip of the tube so that it easily enters your crotch, then add melted silicone glue to the neck area and this will support the silicone even more, it needs to cool and this The silicone lasts to continue working.

R69: (7sc, 1dec)x6 (48)

R70: (14sc, 1dec)x3 (45)

R71-74: 45sc

R75: (3sc, 1dec)x9 (36)

R76: (2sc, 1dec)x9 (27)

Note: Fill very well, always keeping the silicone tube as centered as possible.

R77: (1sc, 1dec)x9 (18)

R78: 18sc

Close with wool needle

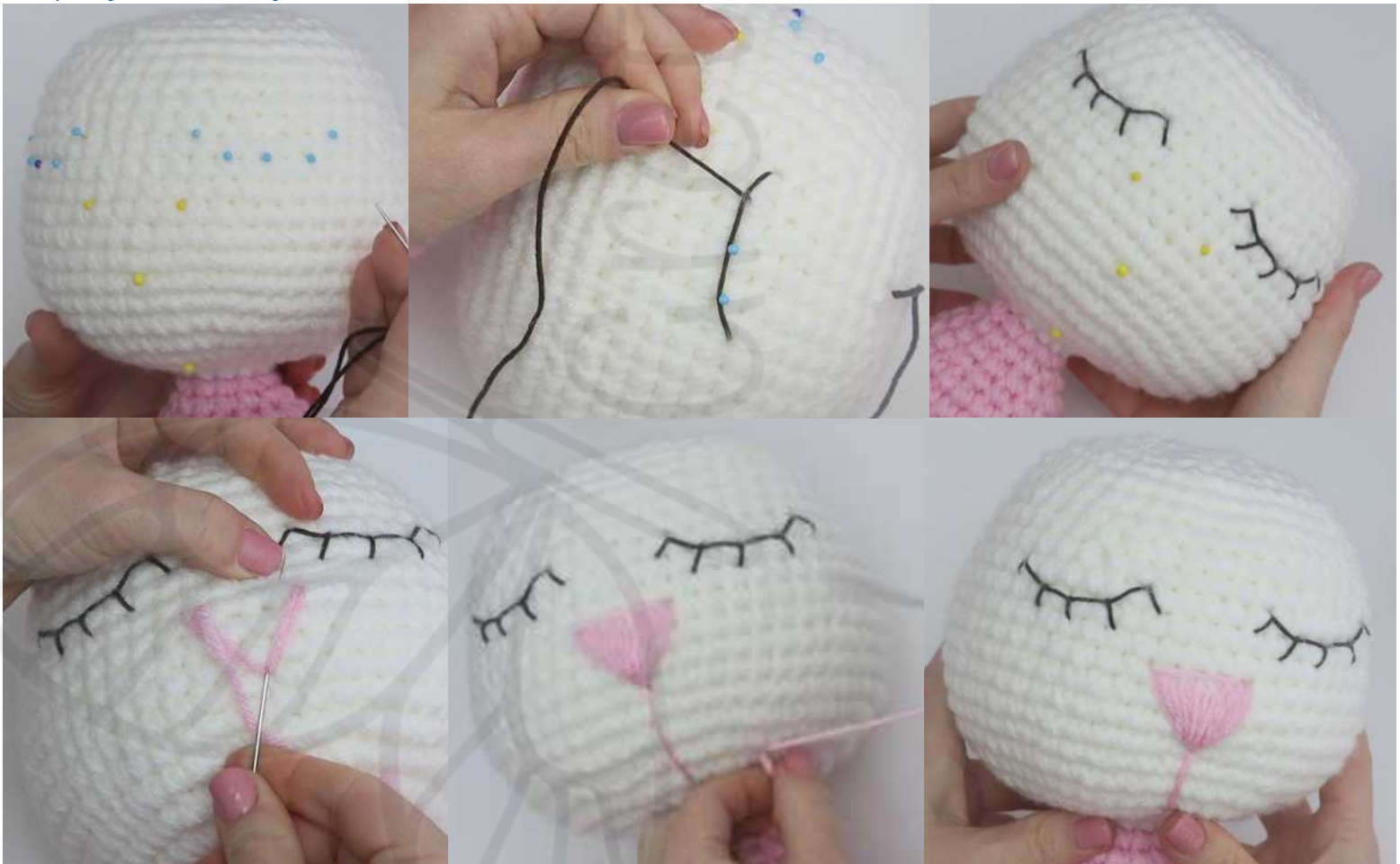
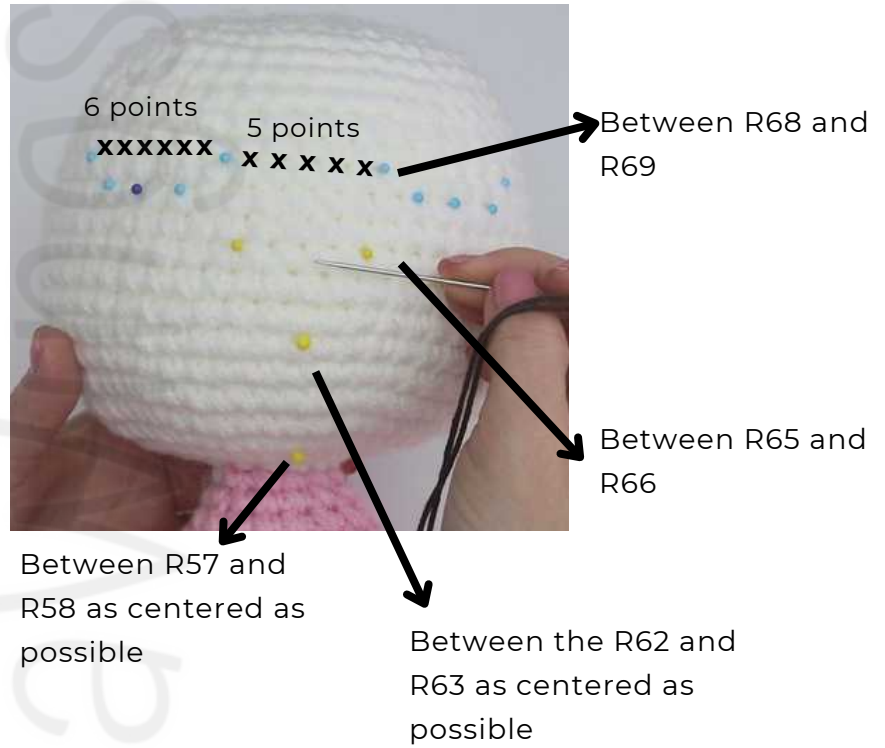
Embroidery of the eyes and nose

Use finer brown thread, approximately 3mm thick, to embroider the eyes.

Use a single strand of pink thread to embroider the nose.

MR, (5ch to go up, 3triple dc, 5ch, 1dc inside the ring)x2

Close and attach to the head
